> easier read, and allow you to quickly know what new initiatives the winners have tried or plan to initiate.


The last major change happened behind the scenes. We had used a mix of paper ballots and electronic voting in the past, but this year we switched entirely to electronic


Tom Triplett says his office furniture and office supply business follows a fairly simple business plan: "We're a smaller company, so we pay attention to the details."

Hubbell Realty Co. is making some adjustments in the face of tough residential and commercial real estate markets during the recovery.

Rick Tollakson, president and CEO, said revenues are down about 20 percent so far this year, but a comparison of year-to-date figures might be misleading because real estate sales in 2010, when the company had a record year for home sales, were influenced by a federal tax credit.

The company will reduce its number of construction starts by about half for the fall building season, he said.

Hubbell is in the process of determining whether to enter the senior housing market to counter slowdowns in other areas of its business.

There is a bright spot, and that is in apartments and

management. Hubbell plans to start construction on an apartment building this month that will offer rents at market rates, a sign that the market sector, which had relied heavily on tax credits for low-income apartments, is regaining its footing.

The company operates more than 2,000 apartment units in Greater Des Moines and has seen occupancy rates hit 100 percent a "couple of times" this year, Tollakson said.

Occupancy of commercial properties has been flat year-to-date, with reduced operating income.

Hubbell recently completed a second project that will be managed by Anawim Housing and is planning a third.
