

hots aren't just for kids! Meet the Polk County Health Department's adult immunization nurses, Sue Boley, RN, BSN and Christine Arauco, RN. They know that contagious diseases can infect people of all ages and that immunizations benefit both individuals and our community.

First, immunizations protect adults from diseases, such as meningitis, pneumonia and shingles, that not only can be painful but can lead to hospitalization or death. Another example is the HPV vaccination, the first vaccination that can prevent cancer in adults and is recommended for adolescents and young adults.

The second benefit of adult immunizations is that they protect those around them. Many people, like the elderly, infants, and people with chronic disease, are vulnerable to infectious diseases and often times catch them from friends and family members. Infants cannot be immunized until they are 6 months old. Because they can catch a contagious disease like pertussis, or whooping cough, from a sibling, parent, grandparent or other caregiver it is important that these others get vaccinated. Nearly half of the babies who get whooping cough have to be hospitalized and of those, one or two of them will die.

Call your health care provider or stop by the Polk County Health Department to ask Sue or Christine if you are up to date on your immunizations.
