

Transition Assistance Program

Right now, you may not be thinking about leaving the military. Good for you! It is an exciting time to be part of America's armed forces. Training opportunities are great, your paycheck is secure, and you love the camaraderie and espirit de corps. You're exactly where you want to be, right now.

However, you will leave the military someday. Sooner or later, every military member becomes a civilian again. You don't have to let this inevitable change catch you unprepared. The Tinker Airman and Family Readiness Center's (A&FRC) Transition Assistance Program can help you exit active duty in a military manner, with your affairs in order, fully informed of the benefits and entitlements due to you as a veteran. It can help you plan, research career options, and develop employment skills you haven't needed while in the military.

The redesigned Transition Assistance Program, known as TAP, was initiated by the Veterans Opportunity to Work Act of 2011. The Veterans Employment Initiative requires that four mandates be completed by all military personnel before separating or retiring. These four mandatory elements are:

1) Pre-separation Briefing

- 2) Transition GPS Workshop
- 3) VA Benefits I & II
- 4) Capstone Event

Pre-separation counseling is the launching point of the program; therefore, every effort should be made to complete it first. People who are retiring can schedule this counseling up to 24 months before retirement, while people who are separating can attend up to 12 months beforehand. The Pre-separation briefing provides an overview of transition benefits, assists members and spouses with assessing individual needs, and includes referral to service providers. This briefing is offered at 2 p.m. every Wednesday at the A&FRC. Seating is limited, contact the A&FRC to schedule a class date. This briefing must be completed prior to enrolling into the Transition GPS Workshop.

The Transition GPS (Goals, Plans, Success) workshop should be the next step in the process (note: some exemptions apply to this mandate). The five day Transition GPS workshop curriculum consists of Individual Transition Plan preparation, Resilient Transitions, Militaryto-Civilian skills review (MOC Crosswalk), Financial Planning, Department of Labor Employment workshop, VA Benefits I & II briefing, Tricare briefing, and the Survivor Benefit Program briefing.

The VA Benefits I & II briefings are mandated for all personnel – members attending the Transition GPS workshops will complete this mandate since it is part of the curriculum. For those people exempt from attending the Transition GPS workshop, a stand-alone VA Benefits I & II class will be provided on the third Monday of each month. Contact the A&FRC to schedule a class date.

The Capstone Event, the culminating activity to verify career readiness, is mandated for all personnel and should be accomplished only after you have



12 AUG | 11 AM - 1 PM FOR MORE INFO 105.731.3118 completed the first three mandatory TAP elements. In conjunction with the A&FRC transition counselor, each commander, or approved designee, is required to sign the DD Form 2958 to document service member's career readiness standards. These standards include having a 12-month post-separation budget plan, as well as a completed resume, ITP and the MOC Gaps Analysis form.

The TAP program also offers service members the option of participating in one or more of the following two-day Transition GPS Tracks:

1. Accessing Higher Education Track: Service members pursuing college education will receive guidance to prepare for the college application process. The Education Track addresses such topics as; identifying educational goals, education funding, and researching and comparing institutions.

2. Entrepreneurship Track: Airmen pursuing self-employment in the private or non-profit sector will learn about the challenges faced by entrepreneurs, the benefits and realities of entrepreneurship, and the steps toward business ownership. Upon completion of the Entrepreneurship Track, service members will develop the initial components of their business plan.

3. Career Technical Training Track: Service members pursuing further technical training will receive guidance and help in selecting schools and technical fields. The Career Technical Training track addresses such topics as selection of a reputable career and technical training school, the application process from start to finish, how to use certification finder Web tools and other Internet resources that identify licensed occupations, and a military occupational code translator.

As you can see, there is a lot to get done to prepare for your transition to civilian life. Separating members should start their transitioning as early as 12 months before their date of separation and retiring members should start as early as 24 months before their date of retirement. Don't wait until the last minute, take the initiative and get an early jump on your transition by calling the A&FRC at 405-739-2747.


