





Welcome to Sunny Fortuna.

You will find Fortuna is the perfect place to base your Redwood Adventure during your visit to the North Coast. Whether you are staying one day, one week or a lifetime, Fortuna offers all of the amenities of a large town with the friendliness of a small community.

Situated a short five hour drive north of the San Francisco Bay area (US 101 exits 687, 688 & 689), Fortuna offers quality lodging, dining, shopping opportunities and traveler services.







Even before it became to be known as Fortuna, there was something special about this little community and it was playing a big part in the success of the Eel River Valley.

It was, one report noted, "a friendly city," opening its doors to individuals and families seeking new and better lives in a variety of different areas, including farming, fishing and logging, in addition to prospecting for gold.

Many settlers originally drawn to California by the prospects of gold soon returned to the farming life they had known in the East, settling in the rich lands of the valley to raise livestock, grains, and a variety of fruits.

The area's ground yielded plentiful crops of fruit and vegetables, while the dairy industry took an early foothold and became the premiere farming occupation.

The popular local products became well-known outside the area and were soon shipped to San Francisco.

People of different cultures settled to work in the fish canneries on the lower Eel River, build roads and railroads.

The area was quickly settled by the Italians, Swiss and Portuguese, and many individuals today can trace their lineage to these immigrants with strong work ethics of a century ago.

This small, unincorporated town first was known as Slide (named after a large slide in the area from present-day State Highway 36 to Kenmar Road) and then was changed to Springville (named after the numerous natural springs).

Originally a company town to accommodate local mill workers, Springville eventually grew large enough to house a post office.

By 1884 the Springville residents had sent a petition to the state legislature asking that the town's name be changed to Fortuna.

It is unsure who officially decided upon the name Fortuna - meaning fortune - but it is believed to have been a local minister and real estate agent who made lots available at affordable prices.

On July 3, 1888, the town and post office were officially named Fortuna. The town quickly grew into its name "fortune," due in part to its excellent location between the redwood forests, the Pacific Ocean and the Eel River

Valley.

After Fortuna was incorporated on Feb. 20, 1906, it established itself as a growing community with a city council, a night watchman and a fire and water committee. It became known for its agricultural excellence in its vegetable crops, berries and fruits as well as fish from the Eel River, although it was the lumbering that put Fortuna on the map.

The lumber mills that had first established Fortuna as a mill town regulated Fortuna's growth, and the area became more populated as the town became more prosperous. People moved to Fortuna with the prospect of good jobs and an orderly town in which to raise their families.

Meanwhile, the railroad was FORTUNA VISITOR'S GUIDE



built to haul trees to the mills and finished wood products to the boat landings. Later it grew to haul freight, farm products and passengers.

The Pacific Lumber Company built a small section from Scotia to Alton and then to its mill in Carlotta, while the completion of the tunnel through Table Bluff in 1885 allowed the Eel River and Eureka Railroad to make daily scheduled runs from Fureka to Alton.

By 1893 a railroad depot had been built in Fortuna.

Work had been started to link the North Coast's railroads with the rest of the world, and on Dec. 1, 1914, the first regular train from out of the area passed through Fortuna at 9:20 p.m. and arrived in Eureka at 10 p.m. Fortuna became a regular stop between Eureka and San Francisco, giving travelers easy access to the area. Trains also became the fastest way for mail to be transported between towns.

The railroad put Fortuna in an enviable position—it had the rail line to town as well as local roads to Ferndale and other towns to the north and south. By having connections in every direction, Fortuna began to grow and the other smaller towns in the area began to lose their prestige. People even began to take the train to Fortuna instead of taking the ocean steamers to Eureka.

Fortuna, originally known for




In Alton, passengers and freight would switch to Pacific Lumber Company trains for the journey to Scotia and points south. Before long the track was extended to Dyerville and local trains made stops at all the small settlements along their tracks,

its ideal location and prosperity, is now known for its eagerly awaited events and festivals.



Humboldt County boasts a scenic 110-mile coastline, more than 160,000 acres of majestic redwoods and an unspoiled terrain of valleys and rolling hills. Visitors of all ages can enjoy some of the nation's finest hiking and boating as well as rafting, kayaking, fishing, horseback riding, golfing and other sports for outdoor enthusiasts. In addition, Humboldt County turns back the clock with its rich Victorian architecture, history and antique shops. Truly a treasure, Humboldt County is a land of visual splendor.

LOCATION—Bordered on one side by the Pacific Ocean, Humboldt County is 200 miles north of San Francisco. Eureka, the county seat, is 284 miles north of San Francisco and 466 miles south of Portland, OR.

POPULATION—132,000. 57,000 people live in seven incorporated cities, the remaining reside in the counties rural communities and countryside.

LAND MASS—2.3 million acres, 3.572 square miles - 80% of which is timberland and recreation areas. The county is mostly mountainous except of the area which surrounds Humboldt Bay.

CLIMATE—Average temperature along the coast in January is 47 degrees; in July it is 56 degrees. Inland temperatures average 85 degrees. Rainfall in Eureka averages 38 inches a year, while on the Lost Coast the rainfall often exceeds 100 inches.

FOUNDED—Humboldt Bay's re-discovery and the County's founding is attributed to Dr. Josiah Gregg and his companions, who traveled west on foot from the Trinity Gold Fields in 1849. The re-discovery of the Humboldt Bay entrance is credited to H.H. Buhne, who piloted a small boat through the Bay entrance and landed on the shores in 1850.

DRIVE YOUR CAR THROUGH AN ACTUAL REDWOOD TREE OR ON TOP OF A REDWOOD LOG!

Count the rings of history as you explore the redwood forest.

There are three "Drive-Through" Trees located on the North Coast. All are privately owned and a fee is charged to drive through. The closest one to Humboldt Redwoods State Park is the Shrine Drive-Thru Tree in Myers Flat, four miles south of the park visitor's center.

THE TREES AND THEIR LOCATIONS HEADING NORTH:

Chandelier Tree: Leggett, South of Humboldt Redwoods State Park (On Drive-Thru Tree Rd. in Drive-Thru Tree Park) Follow the signs on Highway 101. 707-925-63 Shrine Drive-Thru Tree, and Drive-Over Tree: Myers Flat (Take the Myers Flat exit from Highway 101) Drive your car through a redwood tree or over a fallen redwood log. The kids will like our two 2-story tree houses and the children's walk-through stump. Visit the redwood gift shop and enjoy ice cream along side the drive-thru tree.





The Rohner Park redwood forest trails are an exhilarating aspect of the park that many people have yet to discover.

The Rohner Park redwood forest trails take hikers through nearly two miles of one of the finest mature second growth redwood forests in Northern California. Most of the forests in Humboldt County that were first harvested about one hundred years ago have been harvested again. But thanks to the Rohner family and the City of Fortuna, this rare type of forest has been preserved and is easily accessible.

In addition to significant redwoods, Rohner Park features a complex undergrowth of native plant life. Hikers on the Rohner Park Trails will observe plentiful wild shrubs and herbs including evergreen huckleberry, red huckleberry, salal, oxalis, Clintonia lilly and many other species.

A BRIEF HISTORY OF ROHNER PARK

The family and descendants of pioneer Henry Rohner transferred Rohner Park to the city of Fortuna through a series of sales and donations dating from 1907 to 1940. Over the years the park has been developed and maintained with the cook shack, picnic area, ball

park, rodeo grounds, Depot Museum and a scenic system of hiking trails.

ALSO IN ROHNER PARK

The Depot Museum, Fortuna's local history museum, was originally built in 1893 and served as an active railway station until 1965. In 1974 the City of Fortuna purchased the building for the purpose of creating a museum and moved it to its current location in Rohner Park. As part of Fortuna's Bicentennial celebration, the Museum had its grand opening on July 4, 1976. Filled with history of the Eel River Valley, the Fortuna Depot Museum is open seven days a week in June, July and August; and open Thursday through Sunday, from September through May. PARKS & RECREATION

The City of Fortuna owns, maintains and operates two Parks—Rohner Park and Newburg Park. Both parks are intensively managed for multiple recreational activities and special events. There is a second growth forest in Rohner Park that is managed to protect its natural features and where hiking trails are available.

Rohner Park is a 55-acre park located in the center of Fortuna; it has a large Pavilion that is used for skating, basketball, dances, parties and other special events. Other facilities include a Rodeo Arena, three Little League baseball fields, batting cages, a recreation softball field, an outdoor basketball court, horseshoe pits, a volleyball court, a pistol range, a cook shack, a deep pit barbecue, two playgrounds, a recreation hall, a large picnic area, several smaller picnic areas, public restrooms, hiking trails, a second growth Redwood forest and a Museum.

In 1979, the City of Fortuna purchased 18 1/5 acres of pastureland and created Newburg Park. Newburg Park has a variety of recreational facilities including: two regulation hardball fields, two regulation softball fields, one regulation soccer field, seven additional soccer fields of varying sizes, a picnic area, a playground, an all weather walking path and public restrooms. If you are planning a wedding or a business meeting, our award-winning River Lodge is an ideal location. The beautiful setting and impeccable service make it one of the best venues on the North Coast.

HEALTH CARE

Health and human services are extremely important in treating and monitoring the needs of the community. Physicians, dentists, optometrists, foot specialists, physical therapy and counseling services are some of the medical services available in Fortuna.

Located in the heart of Fortuna, Redwood Memorial Hospital is a full-service, 25-bed critical access hospital that features a 24-hour emergency room.

Located next to the hospital is the Fortuna Community Health Center (open as of July 2018). The state-of- the-art, 32,000 square-foot facility provides medical, dental, tele-medicine and behavioral health services. The Health Center has a total of 30 medical exam rooms, 7 dental operatories, a diagnostic laboratory, a medication dispensary, a teaching kitchen, a behavioral health suite with three private offices and three conference rooms.

COMMUNITY CENTER COMING SOON

The Gene Lucas Community Center will be located adjacent to Newberg Park. The 18,000 square foot facility will provide activity and event space and house The Fortuna Senior Center, The Multi-Generational Center (MGC) and will be home of the McLean Foundation.
