

Building Healthy Smiles & Lasting Relationships Meet Dr. Andrew Rivers and Rivers Family & Cosmetic Dentistry

Six years ago, when longtime Mocksville dentist Dr. Gary Prillaman decided to hang up his lab coat and sell his practice, he began the search for a new dentist who would be a good match for both the practice and the community. As it turned out, Dr. Andrew Rivers was a perfect fit.

Dr. Rivers and his wife, Katie, are from Alabama, and quickly fell in love with Mocksville and Davie County.

"We love the area," he says. "When we started looking to buy a practice, we also knew that we wanted to start a family. Davie County has excellent schools, and the area is just quiet enough for our tastes."

Fast forward six years and Rivers Family Dentistry, located at 118 Hospital Street in Mocksville, is anything but quiet. "Anytime there is a change or when a practice is sold, you expect some attrition," he says. "We've steadily grown though."

The practice — originally Hospital Pharmacy — has undergone its fair share of changes. Dr. Prillaman uplifted the building to a dental office, and as his business grew, he added more square footage to it within five years of opening his doors in 1981. Dr. Rivers has also given the former drug store a facelift, completing interior renovations in 2014. The exterior was completed in 2017.



The charm of the old pharmacy hasn't been lost, however.

"It's a neat old building," says Dr. Rivers. "You can still see remnants of the old drive-through pharmacy. The drive-

through window still exists on the left side of the building and can be seen behind the front desk."

What also remains is the commitment to serving the people of Davie County. Dr. Rivers prides himself on providing quality general and cosmetic dentistry for the whole family. According to Dr. Rivers, the best thing about being a general dentist is that it allows him to continue to see his patients routinely throughout his career, promoting not just great relations, but friendships as well.





"I think having those relationships with our patients allows us, as a practice, to offer the type of personal service that is becoming more rare and almost nonexistent in larger communities," he says.

In a profession where many doctors are seeking to specialize and set themselves apart, often only seeing a patient a handful of times, he says he enjoys seeing the same people regularly.

"I love to see the families that come through my door," he says. "It's so interesting to get to know generations of the same family, especially here in Davie County where family and tradition are such important parts of the community. It's great to really get to know people."

Though he offers general dentistry for all ages, he also

says he receives a lot of gratification from performing cosmetic procedures as well.

"When someone walks into my office with no confidence, and spends an hour-and-a-half in my chair, and then walks out with tears of joy and a big smile on their face," he says, "that's something I really enjoy. I love knowing

that I can help people feel better about themselves."

Residents & Businesses Receive Emergency Alerts

Davie County is now using Everbridge Resident Alerts to communicate with citizens and businesses during emergencies and other critical events.

The emergency notification system will be used to alert residents about a variety of events, ranging from severe weather, fires, floods and other emergencies, to more routine announcements, such as road closures and water utility maintenance. Messages will be sent to residents on their preferred contact paths — cell phone, SMS, home phone, email, fax, pager and more — to ensure real-time access to potentially lifesaving information. Residents listed in the Davie County 911 database will be automatically subscribed to alerts by phone, but the system does allow citizens to self-register, provide additional contact information or opt out.

"We have a commitment to ensure public safety, community awareness and emergency response. To uphold this, when critical information and public service announcements are available, we need to reach our residents as quickly and reliably as possible," said County Manager, John Eller. "The emergency notification system allows us to disseminate this information across all types of devices, ensuring residents have access to real-time public information when they need it the most."

Residents are encouraged to register immediately to receive these alerts by visiting the Davie County website at **DavieCountyNC.gov** and clicking on the banner titled Emergency Notification System. The banner will direct you to the location where you can create your account and select subscription options.

Are You Ready to Invest in Yourself?



Deano's — Serving Up 20 Years

"You're crazy." "Nobody will be able to see you down there in that hole."

That's what people told Dean Allen and his wife Paula 21 years ago when they bought a tiny piece of land down the hill behind Napa Auto Parts in downtown Mocksville.

Turns out, people didn't need to see the Allens' restaurant. Word of mouth and consistently good food have made Deano's Barbecue a 20-year success in its current location. For Dean Allen, the love of barbecue and food started way before 1998 though.

Dean began his restaurant career at Buck's Barbecue when he was in high school. Located on Highway 158 in the location of what is now MawMaw's Kitchen, Buck's gave Dean the opportunity to work as a carhop and begin learning about the restaurant business. By 1975, Dean took over the restaurant and renamed it, making it the very first Deano's Barbecue location. After five years, Dean closed shop and went to work in the Fork community, serving up Lexington-style barbecue at the former Hendrix Barbecue on Highway 64.

As life goes, the Allens experienced twists and turns, with Dean even taking a stint as a car salesman. But the love of feeding people and cooking barbecue never left him. Finally, another job change in 1997 became the straw that broke the proverbial camel's back. His wife encouraged him to chase after his passion and bring some stability to their family. But she had one stipulation — she insisted they buy their own place. Dean agreed, but he had a stipulation of his own, too.

"You, me, and God," he told his wife. "That's it. No partners."

And it's worked. For 20 years, Dean and Paula have been serving the people of Davie County, as well as folks from all over. Using what he learned over the years, Dean's brand of barbecue is a combination of all his favorites, still hickory smoked and chopped fresh every morning. His famous dip is an adaptation of the dip that used to be served at Hendrix. The secret recipe was shared with him by Mr. Hendrix — a gesture so sacred and special, Dean says he carries Mr. Hendrix's original handwritten recipe with him in his wallet.

While the homemade food is excellent and Deano's prices remain reasonable, Paula says the success of the restaurant isn't only owed to the quality of the food.

"It's because of Dean," she says. "It's his personality. I laughed a while back and called him the restaurant's social director, but he really is. He speaks to everyone, and he remembers people. He puts his heart into it, and that means a lot to people."

Though Dean and Paula don't know what the long-term future holds for Deano's — their girls aren't sure if they want to take over the family business one day — for now, they say they're just happy to be here.

"We're so grateful to have been here 20 years, and as long as he wants to continue cooking barbecue, that's what we'll do. We close one week a year for vacation, and a few days at Thanksgiving and Christmas," she laughs. "That's about all the time I can get him away."

Deano's is located at 140 N. Clement Street in Mocksville, and they are open Tuesday-Saturday, from 11 a.m. to 8 p.m.

FOR SALE Real Estate Season is Near How Your Transaction Can Go More Smoothly

'For Sale' signs will soon be sprouting up as quickly as spring tulips and daffodils.

The busiest home buying and selling season is anticipated to be another good year for real estate transactions. But what if your real estate deal encounters some bumpy roads? Knowing the ramifications of a few typical legal issues could help your deal go smoothly.

What if I change my mind about the sale?

You've signed on the dotted line, but now you're getting cold feet. How binding is the real estate contract you signed and what are the legal consequences if you walk away?

As part of that legal binding pact, the buyer makes a deposit, or 'earnest money', to the seller. If the seller terminates or breaches the contract, or a term of the 'Offer to Purchase' contract is not satisfied, the buyer gets the earnest money back. However, if the buyer breaches the contract, the deposit belongs to the seller. This is the seller's sole and exclusive remedy and is considered compensatory damages.

The buyer is also required to pay a due diligence fee, additional money paid to the seller for the right to terminate the contract for any reason or no reason at all during the specified due diligence period.

If the buyer offers a timely termination notice to the seller during that period the buyer gets both the earnest money and the due diligence money.

However, due diligence money is non-refundable to the buyer after the specified time, unless the seller breaches or fails to materially comply with the contract and the buyer agrees to terminate.

In addition to these ramifications, a buyer or seller could have other additional legal consequences for walking away from a sale. Before backing out, get legal advice.

What if I don't agree with the neighborhood HOA? Can I refuse the fee?

A Homeowners' Associations (HOA) isn't always the most popular group in a neighborhood. When buying into a community with an HOA, you are contractually bound by the terms of the restrictive covenants, which states that you can not opt out of paying HOA fees regardless of whether or not you use the common areas or amenities paid for by the HOA dues.

If you decide not to pay your HOA fees, in NC the HOA organization can fine you and file a lien against your home and even foreclose on the property for non-payment. If they don't foreclose and there is a lien against the property for non-payment of dues it will have to be satisfied when the home is sold.

If you are thinking of buying a home in a planned community, read the covenants or meet with a lawyer to review them before you have buyer's remorse.

BB&T Sports Park: An Active Partnership for Sports, Health, Wellness

When the broad green fields of Bermuda Run's BB&T Sports Park are swarming with children and soccer balls this spring, the picture will tell an even bigger story than fun and good exercise. Wake Forest Baptist Medical Center has partnered with Twin City Sports Association (TCSA) to serve as the official medical provider of the youth sports organization.

Chad Brown, president of Wake Forest Baptist Health — Davie Medical Center, said, "It's amazing to drive by the complex during a weekend tournament to see the sheer volume of people involved. Families, youth from around the region — it's really a community coming together to promote wellness. Between the Twins, the Town of Bermuda Run and Davie Medical Center, a lot of great things will be accomplished in the future. This aligns perfectly with our mission of improving the health of our community."

Sharing Healthful Activities

There are nearly 3,000 boys, girls and adults involved in TCSA programs, with games, practices and other events being held year-round. Add parents, siblings, and grandparents to the mix of individuals and families served by the organization, and it's something in the range of 10,000 people getting outdoors and sharing the values of health and community.

Twin City Sports Association was incorporated in 1979 as Twin City Youth Soccer Association, with the purpose of developing and advancing youth soccer in the Winston-Salem area and allowing players to develop to their highest potential. With the organization's emphasis on developing confident players and giving everyone a chance to play, regardless of financial ability, the relationship with the area's leading health care organization is a natural one. The official partnership announcement comes after a longstanding relationship of 10 years.

"Our organizations share many of the same values," said Scott Wollaston, executive director of TCSA. "Our goal is to provide all of our players the opportunity to play to their potential, and this relationship with Wake Forest Baptist will certainly help us accomplish that."

Access for All Families

The Twins Foundation — which helps to ensure access for all players and their families — awarded more than \$60,000 this year in financial assistance and scholarships

to club families, and operates a community outreach program that helps improve fitness, self-esteem and social skills of local children with disabilities.

Wollaston said, "TCSA seeks to provide the exemplary soccer experience, emphasizing the club's commitment to the areas of ambition, humility and community through the relationship between players, coaches and parents."

The Wake Forest Baptist sponsorship of BB&T Sports Park and Twin City Youth Soccer Association has begun as a 10-year partnership with significant impact on Davie County as well as the surrounding region.

As part of the agreement, Wake Forest Baptist is providing medical kits and CPR training for coaches and staff, along with education about proper nutrition, conditioning and injury prevention to children, teens and parents involved in TCSA programs.

"Youth sports offer such great benefits for those who participate in them," said Brown. "This partnership is a natural fit and will help us support the health, safety and physical fitness of young athletes, their families and members of our community. We're proud to be a part of this, not only from a preventive health perspective, but also when things don't go exactly as planned, in the case of an injury, we are there to take care of them and to be a partner in their health care.

"This is a milestone agreement important to Davie Medical Center, the Town of Bermuda Run, and a commitment to wellness for our community."

Artificial turf fields, walking trails and a playground, all carrying the Wake Forest Baptist name, are among some of the additions to TCSA's soccer complex, located just west of Winston-Salem, in Davie County. The trails and playground, soon to open, will provide increased opportunities for everyone in the community to enjoy outdoor activities.

Bret Nicks, M.D., chief medical officer of Wake Forest Baptist Health — Davie Medical Center has firsthand experience with BB&T Sports Park and TCSA. He said, "As a parent with young players and an emergency medicine physician, I'm pleased that this partnership will foster the health of our community while providing children and parents the opportunity learn more about safety and prevention — an impact that reaches beyond the field and into their daily lives."

Nicks is also a professor of emergency medicine and past president of North Carolina College of Emergency Physicians. He added, "This is an outstanding opportunity to further community health through our region's leading sports medicine team, Brenner Children's Hospital and the array of services offered by Wake Forest Baptist to players and their families."

Athletes and Families Will Have Sports Medicine Support



We are in an exciting time in Davie County, and the Foundation looks forward to being part of a very bright future for the entire community!







advances in anesthesia

Advances in anesthesia, coupled with the extensive training of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons (OMS), allow for the delivery of safe, cost-effective, convenient, and minimally stressful oral/dental, implant, and facial surgical care.

Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons are the only dental specialists trained in all aspects of anesthesia administration, from local to general anesthesia. Following four years of dental school, an OMS completes four to six years of training in a hospital-based surgical residency program alongside medical residents in General Surgery, Anesthesia, Otolaryngology (ENT), and other specialties. During this time, OMS residents serve in the medical anesthesiology service, where they learn to evaluate patients for anesthesia, deliver different anesthetics, and monitor post-anesthetic patients. OMS residents also spend multiple years delivering anesthesia care to their own oral surgery patients. In addition, many Oral Surgeons complete medical school as well, further enhancing their breadth of medical knowledge and ability to care for a wide variety of patients.

The ability to provide patients with safe, effective, outpatient anesthesia has distinguished the specialty of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery since its earliest days. Using their training, the OMS is able to effectively treat dental, oral, and facial pain, as well as dental anxiety. An OMS is experienced in airway management, endotracheal intubation, establishing and maintaining intravenous lines, and managing anesthetic complications and emergencies. An OMS, unlike other "sedation dentists", is also licensed to deliver deep sedation and general anesthesia, and can manage a surgical airway if necessary.

An OMS is trained to deliver anesthesia to all age groups, including pediatric patients. Delivering minimally stressful care to children for surgical procedures is





important to prevent a traumatic fear and avoidance of future dental care. Furthermore, with an OMS in North Carolina, anesthesia services are often covered by medical insurance for children less than 9 years of age, and for persons with significant mental, behavioral, or physical conditions.

The majority of OMS procedures are performed in the office, with accompanying anesthesia administration. This treatment approach is convenient and cost-effective. The comfortable, personalized setting of the OMS office minimizes waiting and recovery time, as compared to having the same procedure performed in a hospital or outpatient surgery center. In addition, in-office procedures and anesthesia delivery are usually less costly than similar care in a hospital or surgery center. However, if one requires anesthesia care in a hospital or specialized facility due to a significant medical history, an OMS, unlike other dental specialists or "sedation dentists", has hospital privileges to provide care in this type of setting.



The War to End All Wars

Davie County's Place in History

In 1917 and 1918, the United States and Davie County were in the thick of World War One. Even though this is a small county, 670 of our men and 3 of our women served in the "War to End All Wars." Two women were yeomen (secretaries), and one was a nurse in Europe. No one is still alive, of course, to tell war stories, and they probably wouldn't if they were asked.

In 2011 and 2012, Marie Craig researched Davie's role in this great war. There were stories to be found from offspring of those who served, and valuable old photos to be copied. The History Room at the library yielded articles and pictures. Interviews produced stories from relatives. A resulting book of 418 pages is available for purchase at the library or from the author. It contains biographies and photographs, description of Army bases, local newspaper articles, and a profile of letters home.

The local newspaper, *The Davie Record*, had many articles about the progress of the war, letters from soldiers serving in Europe, and appeals for people to conserve food at home so that the military guys would have plenty to eat.

The United States was unprepared to go to war in 1917. The soldiers, themselves, helped to build some of the military camps for training. Before the actual cannons arrived at the bases, recruits would practice beside wooden mockups of cannons. Camps in Charlotte, Greenville, SC and Spartanburg SC no longer exist, but were built in 1917 as was Camp Jackson in Columbia SC.





Of these 670 men, 118 were Negro (term used at that time). They were not involved in combat, but served behind the lines by taking care of the mules, carrying supplies, and building caskets. Some of the more valiant ones were honored by the French government.

The Veterans' Memorial built on the square in Mocksville in 1987 had listed 18 names of men who died in WWI, but in Marie's research, she found 11 more men who had died during this war. Those names were added to the left edge of the monument. The winters during 1917 and 1918 were especially cold, and the Spanish influenza epidemic and meningitis took a heavy toll. Of the 29 men, 10 died because of warfare and the other 19 of serious illnesses.

Davie County men and women served well. Some of the guys looked so very young to have been drafted and sent out of the county and country for probably the first time in their lives to face an enemy. Mothers and fathers were worried whether they would return. One soldier wrote letters home concerned that his father had to do all the work on the farm with him gone.

It was a sad, scary time for everybody. But when the men returned home at the end of 1918, they picked up their lives and continued onward.


