





#### MISS SHIRLEY'S

750 E. PRATT ST. OR 513 W. COLD SPRING LANE

A hearty breakfast at Miss Shirley's (locations at the Inner Harbor and Roland Park) is fuel for a big day of adventure. Try rich dishes like crab cake and fried green tomato eggs benedict or coconut cream stuffed French toast.

#### NATIONAL AQUARIUM

501 E. PRATT ST.

Get up close and personal with thousands of species such as jellyfish at Living Seashore's touch pools, tiger salamanders during Critter Chats, or bottlenose dolphins while watching a 4D immersion film.

#### **MARYLAND** SCIENCE CENTER

601 LIGHT ST.

This hands-on museum is perfect for exploring everything from dinosaurs to human anatomy. Check the schedule of The Shed for hands-on events and classes that teach DIY skills through design.



#### ORIOLE PARK AT CAMDEN YARDS STADIUM TOUR

333 W. CAMDEN ST.

You may not be able to catch an Órioles game until Opening Day on April 4, but you can go behind-thescenes at the most beautiful ballpark in baseball yearround. Nearby, learn more about one of Baltimore's most famous Orioles at the Babe Ruth Birthplace and Museum.

#### **ARRIE MURRAY NATURE CENTER**

1901 RIDGETOP RD.

Located within Gwynns Falls/Leakin Park, this nature center – which is dedicated to baseball legend Eddie Murray's mother - educates visitors about the park's creatures.

#### LEBANESE TAVERNA

719 S. PRESIDENT ST.

The kids' menu at this Mediterranean restaurant isn't restricted to standard kid fare like chicken fingers. Instead, find tasty specialties like hummus, falafel and chicken shawarma. Kids also receive crayons and menus loaded with puzzles.

#### KIMPTON HOTEL **MONACO BALTIMORE**

2 N. CHARLES ST.

Rest your head in this historic hotel, a 1906 Beaux-Arts building once home to the B&O Railroad Headquarters. The soaring marble staircases, crystal chandeliers, and Tiffany stained glass windows will dazzle you, and kids will love the in-room bunk beds and video games.



#### **EXPLORE BALTIMORE'S PAST**

Learn about the city's role in the War of 1812 and the Civil War, and explore the significant historic structures still standing today.

#### THE AVENUE BAKERY

2229 PENNSYLVANIA AVE.

Opened on historic Pennsylvania Avenue this bakery is famous for "Poppay's Rolls," enormous buttery soft bread rolls. Trail markers and photos of the historic Pennsylvania Avenue Heritage Trail, and murals depicting famous African Americans with ties to Baltimore, decorate the bakery's lobby and garden.

#### **FORT MCHENRY** NATIONAL MONUMENT & HISTORIC SHRINE

2400 E. FORT AVE.

A key site in Baltimore's battle against the British during the War of 1812, Fort McHenry is perhaps most famous as the birthplace of "The Star-Spangled Banner." Start your morning by helping a park ranger raise the fort's flag and learn more about its role during other American wars. And if you're lucky, you may even

catch a reenactment.



#### MARYLAND HISTORICAL SOCIETY

201 W. MONUMENT ST.

Here you can see the oldest known surviving manuscript of Francis Scott Key's "The Star-Spangled Banner." Try your hand at oystering on the Chesapeake Bay, and learn about Maryland home life throughout the centuries.

#### WASHINGTON **MONUMENT**

699 N. CHARLES ST.

In the heart of Mount Vernon sits the world's oldest monument dedicated to George Washington-and yes, that means it was built before the one in Washington, D.C.! Climb 227 steps to the top for a sweeping panoramic view of the cityscape, or stay at ground level to learn about the monument's history and neighborhood on the interactive touchscreens.

#### LEXINGTON MARKET

400 W. LEXINGTON ST.

Grab lunch at the historic Lexington Market, the nation's oldest continually operating market. Some say Faidley's, one of the oldest vendors at the market, makes the city's best crab cake.



#### **B&O RAILROAD** MUSEUM

901 W. PRATT ST.

Located in what was once an active railroad station, the BSO Railroad Museum celebrates the history of the Baltimore & Ohio line, the birthplace of modern

American railroading. Visitors can trace the path of the country's first mile of railroad track ever laid and peek inside historic train cars.

#### WOODBERRY KITCHEN

2010 CLIPPER PARK RD.

James Beard Awardwinning chef and owner Spike Gjerde opened Woodberry Kitchen in a former mill, and the building's historic character is preserved in the exposed brick and wood beams. The menu reflects a deep appreciation of the Chesapeake Bay's culinary traditions, with all-local sourcing.

#### LORD BALTIMORE HOTEL

20 W. BALTIMORE ST.

Named for George Calvert, Lord Baltimore and founder of the Maryland colony, the Lord Baltimore Hotel was downtown's last highrise building featuring classical ornamentation. Its splendid two-story lobby welcomes guests with stately columns and



#### **LIVING** WELL

Vacation doesn't have to mean your wellness routine goes by the wayside. Baltimore offers healthy eating and active living options (plus some pampering) that'll show you the city in a whole new way.

#### STALL 11

301 W. 29TH ST.

This stall, in Remington's modern food hall R. House, serves up an entirely plantbased menu using sustainable and local ingredients. The global street food theme includes dishes that vary from Korean barbecue cauliflower and mushroom "cheesesteaks" to freshpressed juices and smoothies.

#### MOVEMENT BODY LAB

301 W. 29TH ST.

After breakfast, head to the second floor of R. House, where Movement Lab offers a variety of mind-body classes and workshops for people of all fitness levels. It's also the only studio in Maryland where you can practice AntiGravity Fitness, with aerial fitness and yoga classes.

#### **ENCANTADA**

800 KEY HWY.

While not entirely vegetarian, Encantada's menu puts vegetables in a starring role, with plant-based dishes like deviled turnips and spicy Nashville cauliflower. A bonus: This restaurant is located on the third floor of the American Visionary Art Museum, so don't forget to leave time to explore after your meal.

#### YOGA

**LOCATIONS VARY** 

A yoga studio isn't the only place to practice in Baltimore. Pop-up classes are springing up at attractions as varied as the Maryland Zoo, American

Visionary Art Museum, Mount Vernon Place outside the Washington Monument and many more. Check online for schedules.

#### TERRAPIN **ADVENTURES**


8600 FOUNDRY ST.

For an adrenaline-filled outdoor experience, climb, swing, jump, kayak, bike hike or zipline at Terrapin Adventures. Test your skills on the climbing tower or aerial ropes course, or take a guided kayak, river tubing or bike tour.

#### LAND OF KUSH

840 N. EUTAW ST.


If you're looking for traditional Baltimore soul food with a lighter touch, try Mount Vernon's vegan Land of Kush. The menu includes dishes like barbeque "ribs," curry "chicken" and vegan mac and cheese. The stellar vegan crab cake is a must-try.



#### **FOUR SEASONS HOTEL & SPA**

200 INTERNATIONAL DR.

While the Four Seasons is an excellent choice for a luxurious stay, the hotel's spa is an attraction all its own. For a real treat, book the spa's Night Experience, which gives two guests exclusive evening access to all of the spa facilities, plus two 80-minute massages, a candlelit rose-petal bath and a multi-course tasting menu on a private terrace.

#### Romare Bearden: Visionary Artist presented by Bank of America

Through March 3, 2019

#### THE REGINALD F. LEWIS MUSEUM

presents more than 70 works by Romare Bearden, a prominent and influential 20th-century African American artist known best for his mixed media and abstract works. The exhibition presents a diverse collection of Bearden's renowned collages, as well as his watercolor paintings, prints and rare archival material, including his illustrations for the Baltimore Afro-American.

Best known for his evocative depictions of the black experience, Bearden was awarded the National Medal of Arts in 1987 by President Ronald Reagan. His works are in more than a dozen major museums, including the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York City. A champion for other African American artists, Bearden founded an arts collective dubbed Spiral in the 1960s to explore how the creative community could play a role in the civil rights movement.

The Lewis Museum's exhibition examines how Bearden encouraged social change by countering racial stereotypes through images drawn from history, literature, the Bible, and his own imagination.



The stately BALTIMORE MUSEUM OF ART, which houses one of the most comprehensive collections of Henri Matisse's prints and drawings, is expanding its modern and contemporary art clout with three standout exhibitions this winter and spring.

Art and war are clearly connected in the BMA's "Monsters & Myths," which presents nearly 90 Surrealist masterworks by artists such as Salvador Dalí, Pablo Picasso, Max Ernst and André Masson, who responded to the rise of Hitler and Fascism in Europe with an extraordinary period of creativity.

Monstrosities in the real world bred monsters in paintings and sculpture, on film and in journals and artists' books. Despite the political and personal turmoil brought on by the Spanish Civil War and World War II, avant-garde artists in Europe and those who sought refuge in the United States pushed themselves to create some of the most potent and striking images of the Surrealist movement.

Highlights of the exhibition include Dalí's "Soft Construction with Boiled Beans (Premonition of a Civil War)" (1936), Ernst's "Europe After the Rain II" (1940-42), Masson's "There is No Finished World" (1942) and Picasso's "Minotauromachy" (1935). Among the works by American artists are Arshille Gorky's "The Unattainable" (1945) and Mark Rothko's "The Syrian Bull" (1943). The exhibition concludes with two films: "Un Chien Andalou" (1929) by Luis Buñuel and Salvador Dalí, and "Meshes of

#### Mark Bradford's 2017 Venice Biennale Exhibition: "Tomorrow Is Another Day" Through March 3, 2019

The BMA's new director Christopher Bedford joined the museum at the same time he was selected as the 2017 commissioner of the U.S. Pavilion at the renowned Venice Biennale. He brought Mark Bradford, the socially conscious Los Angeles artist and a leading figure in contemporary art, to display his work exploring how traditionally marginalized communities address issues of social and economic justice. That buzzedabout, multimedia show is on display through the winter. While in Baltimore, Bradford is also partnering with a nearby youth center to teach art workshops and create silk-screened T-shirts and tote bags, which will be available at a pop-up shop adjacent to the exhibition.


#### "John Waters: **Indecent Exposure**"




Here's what to know about these hotbeds of artistic activity.

#### 1 STATION NORTH

Centrally located and aptly named Station North, a few blocks north of Pennsylvania Station, is a collection of artists' live-work spaces, galleries, rowhomes and businesses. The main artery of North Avenue is lined with recently renovated and reimagined arts hubs, such as independent film center Stavros Niarchos Foundation Parkway Theatre, entrepreneur work space Open Works and multipurpose entertainment venue Motor House, home to the oftphotographed Graffiti Alley – the only legal place in the city to create street art. The area also boasts multiple music venues, dance clubs and beloved bars, as well as the public project Open Walls Baltimore, which created dozens of colorful murals in the neighborhood.

#### 2 HIGHLANDTOWN

Highlandtown in Southeast Baltimore is a culturally diverse neighborhood with an especially lively Latino community that not only inspires interesting art, but also delicious food. The district's unofficial headquarters is Creative Alliance, which offers a mindboggling collection of programs ranging from world music concerts to burlesque shows. This district is the largest geographically, with dozens of art galleries and studios and a popular monthly art walk, when businesses welcome the public with receptions and special events.



#### **3** BROMO

Located in Downtown Baltimore. the Bromo is the youngest arts district, mixing established professional theaters, underground galleries and up-and-coming performing arts venues. Anchored to the south by the Bromo Seltzer Arts Tower, the district welcomes theatergoers who can see the professional resident acting company at Everyman Theatre. national touring Broadway shows at the Hippodrome Theatre and experimental theater and performance art at several underground venues with loads of character.



ANDAMENTO STUDIO AND GALLERY specializes in fine art mosaics by Gail Rosen and jewelry designs by Gina Tackett. 3406 CHESTNUT AVE.

THE BROMO SELTZER ARTS TOWER has been a part of Baltimore's skyline since 1911 and since 2007 has housed artist studios and art galleries winging out from its winding staircase.

21 S. EUTAW ST.

C. GRIMALDIS GALLERY, an institution in the Baltimore art scene, is the longest continually operating gallery in the city. Go here for contemporary and modern works. 523 N. CHARLES ST.

CRYSTAL MOLL GALLERY, on the main street of historic Federal Hill, features urban landscape art in Moll's plein air style.

GALERIE MYRTIS in Station North has a reputation for exhibiting cutting-edge work by primarily African American artists on the cusp of national and international acclaim. 2224 N CHADLES ST

#### MAHOGANY EXCHANGE

showcases African art, fashion, books and other items.

MICA (Maryland Institute College of Art), one of the nation's oldest art schools, hosts more than 100 exhibitions annually, and has three major on-campus gallery spaces where the public can view work by its talented faculty, students and visiting artists.

VARIOUS LOCATIONS

THE METRO GALLERY is a gritty multipurpose bar and music venue. Head here for rock and metal shows or to view works by emerging visual artists.

MOTOR HOUSE is an arts hub in Station North that presents performances and concerts as well as gallery shows spotlighting works by Baltimore artists.

some fun.

# Bite

One of the best ways to get to know Baltimore is through its food. The restaurant scene has been drawing the attention of some big names, from internationally known and award-winning chefs to trusted publications like *Zagat*, which called Baltimore one of the "most exciting food cities in America."

From the husband-and-wife duo behind Bluebird Cocktail Room in Baltimore's Hampden neighborhood comes Little Bird Coffee Bar, an Italian-inspired café serving coffee and espresso drinks, a selection of house-made pastries and classic Italian delicacies — think homemade pasta and a marinara sauce recipe that's been passed down for generations.

And from the same restaurant group behind The Bygone, Loch Bar, Ouzo Bay and Azumi comes Tagliata. Named one of America's best wine restaurants by *Wine Enthusiast*, Tagliata is an Italian chophouse in Harbor East. Head here for handmade pasta, hand-cut steaks, charcuterie and a wine list with more than 1,000 bottles.



#### WHAT'S NEW

A glamorous rooftop restaurant at the Four Seasons, The Bygone serves a menu of upscale, classic American cuisine in a space styled to be reminiscent of the roaring '20s. The menu boasts tableside presentations for dishes such as duck flambé and a tuna tartare "cigar." (See page 40 for more on interactive dining experiences in Baltimore.)

Horseshoe Casino recently introduced celebrity chefbacked restaurants Gordon Ramsay Steak and GDL Italian by Giada De Laurentiis. They join Food Network star Guy Fieri, who has two casino spots: Guy Fieri's Baltimore Kitchen + Bar and Guy's Bar-B-Que Joint.

James Beard Award-winning chef Andrew Carmellini brought his culinary chops to both Rye Street Tavern, a waterfront American restaurant adjacent to the Sagamore Spirit Distillery in Port Covington, and Rec Pier Chop House, an Italian steakhouse in the Sagamore Pendry Hotel in historic Fell's Point.

Two of Baltimore's historic markets are working on upgrades scheduled to be completed soon. Federal Hill's Cross Street Market is undergoing a \$7.3 million renovation to give the 67-year-old building more natural light and room for new vendor concepts this spring. In Fell's Point, the long-vacant north shed of Broadway Market has been remodeled and is scheduled to open in early 2019 with 11 vendors,



including three from the market's south shed. Once complete, construction on the south shed will begin to transform into The Choptank, a Maryland crab house by Atlas Restaurant Group and Captain James Landing. Plans call for plenty of outdoor seating.





The Elk Room



The owners of Union Craft Brewing, Baltimore's fastest growing craft brewery, opened Union Collect (e, an incubator space anchored by Union's expanded brewery and taproom. The site boasts a beer garden and kitchen run by Well Crafted Kitchen—try WCK's wood-fired pizzas and small plates. Also in the massive converted warehouse are a coffee shop, an independent spirits distillery and The Charmery, an ice cream shop serving handcrafted, artisanal scoops.

Baltimore's newest import is the Guinness Open Gate Brewery & Barrel House, the iconic Irish beer brand's first location in America since 1954. The brewery is open for tours and tastings, including the chance to try exclusive and experimental beers brewed in-house. Lunch and dinner are served at the on-site restaurant.

If beer isn't your libation of choice, Baltimore is also home to some fierce contenders in the craft cocktail world. Bluebird Cocktail Room is a literary-themed bar in Hampden with a menu that changes seasonally. The cocktails (named after the likes of Ernest Hemingway and Virginia Woolf) are complemented by European

bistro fare such as charcuterie, fried sweetbreads and steak frites.

Named one of *Esquire's* best bars in America, **The Elk Room** is a speakeasy-style spot with an
unmarked door and low lighting. Handcrafted cocktails
come with lavish touches like hand-cut ice cubes and
liquid nitrogen-frozen berries.

For a true speakeasy experience, don't miss The Owl Bar, located in the 115-year-old Belvedere Hotel in Mount Vernon. The bar actually lived through Prohibition and has seen many famous faces pass through its doors. The two large plaster owls atop the bar once served as a subtle way to let customers know whether it was safe to indulge, and now serve as a reminder of the building's history.

Maryland was once the center of rye whiskey production in the country, and Sagamore Spirit Distillery aims to bring that legacy back. Tours and tastings are available, and there's a visitor center and gift shop on site.







When it comes to adventure and seeing the sights, Baltimore offers something for every taste and budget-from one-of-a-kind art displays to city tours that get to the beating heart of our culture.

The Walters Art Museum reopened the historic 19thcentury mansion at One West Mount Vernon Place. Stop here to take in stunning architectural features and details, including a grand spiral staircase, Tiffany stained-glass skylight and carved wooden bookcases.

At the American Visionary Art Museum, Parenting: An Art without a Manual explores all types of child-rearing, from the animal kingdom to the role of grandparents, teachers, and foster and adoptive parents, examined through art, humor, historic text and first-hand testimony.

For more can't-miss art exhibitions and galleries, check out our feature starting on page 18.

Skip the traditional walking tour and explore the city with Baltimore Urban Adventures. A native guide will take you off the beaten path through neighborhoods such as Fell's Point and Mount Vernon, and teach you about the history of the area while you sample local fare.

If you're up for some competition, try Urban Adventure Quest, a modern scavenger hunt inspired by TV show The Amazing Race. A smartphone leads

teams through the city with clues and challenges; you can race other teams or simply see the sights while playing a game.

Escape rooms are trending across America, but places like Baltimaze, Lock N' Key and Charm City Clue Room in Baltimore combine the thrill of the challenge with local history and folklore for an experience you can't get anywhere else. Work together to capture bandits on the B&O Railroad or solve the mystery behind Edgar Allan Poe's death.



# Stay >

Baltimore's hotels combine thoughtful touches and distinctive décor to serve a luxe-meets-charm experience so inviting you won't want to leave.

Mount Vernon's newest hotel, Hotel Revival, carries on the property's art-centric legacy. Once a private mansion owned by an art enthusiast, and formerly the site of the Baltimore Museum of Art's inaugural exhibition in 1923, the hotel features locally curated art by Paradigm Gallery + Studio, a custom Baltimore Album Quilt wallpaper and a vintagestyle rotating ticker board in the lobby. The hotel's signature restaurant and bar Square Meal and the enclosed rooftop bar Topside have quickly become local favorites.

In the heart of historic Fell's Point stands the gleaming Sagamore Pendry Baltimore, a luxury hotel built atop the restored Recreation Pier. During its lifetime, the pier welcomed immigrants from around the world, and was once used as a community center, a storage cargo port and a set for television shows. The luxe property features 128 guest rooms and suites overlooking the harbor, a waterfront infinity pool, a ballroom, a whiskey bar and an interior garden with a sculpture by artist Fernando Botero. The hotel recently joined forces with the Baltimore Water Taxi to offer a private water taxi for hotel guests to Port Covington's Sagamore Spirit Distillery and Rye Street Tavern.

The Crowne Plaza Baltimore has opened after a multimillion-dollar renovation, transforming one tower of the complex shared by the Radisson Hotel Baltimore Downtown-Inner Harbor. The revamped hotel includes an onsite restaurant, a grab-and-go market, a 24-hour fitness center, an outdoor pool and refurbished guest rooms.

Coming in winter 2019 is Canopy, a new Hilton hotel brand aimed at helping travelers discover the best of the cities they visit. The 156-room property will be located in Harbor Point, a new waterfront development between Harbor East and historic Fell's Point, and will feature a first-floor waterfront lobby and a restaurant with an outdoor terrace.







# Southeast Baltimore

## Inner Harbor 1

Say "Baltimore" and most out-of-towners will respond "Inner Harbor." That's no surprise – the city's showpiece and tourism center boasts a bevy of hotels, restaurants, shops and entertainment venues encircling the water. It's a great place to stroll, explore Baltimore's maritime heritage or sightsee at national attractions.

WATER TOURS Take a tour boat, a water taxi or a paddle boat for a waterside perspective of the Inner Harbor and beyond.

UNDER THE SEA The National Aquarium provides fish-eye views of the underwater ecosystem, including the colorful world of jellies.

WHAT A VIEW You can see for miles and miles from the **Top of the World** — also known as the 27th floor of the World Trade Center.

BEENTERTAINED From beer and bingo at Power Plant Live to concerts by national acts at the MECU Pavilion, there's always something to see.



# Southeast Baltimore





Providing perhaps the best view in the city, Federal Hill was an instrumental location in defending Baltimore against the British during the War of 1812. Now it is a gem of a popular neighborhood.

FRESH FOOD Cross Street Market, one of Baltimore's renowned city markets, has been selling fresh meats, seafood, ethnic foods and produce for more than 170 years. The market is currently undergoing a massive renovation.

HARD WORK Try your hand at oyster-shucking or canning at Baltimore Museum of Industry, which showcases many of the occupations that built the city, and many that make it work today.

SELF-TAUGHT ARTISTS Prepare to be entertained and delighted at The American Visionary Art Museum, a Baltimore original featuring the work of self-taught artists in permanent and visiting exhibitions.



GET THE SPIRIT The Sagamore Spirit Distillery, maker of Sagamore Rye, and its adjacent Rye Street Tavern are two of the early draws. Take a tour, sip a sample and enjoy the view.

#### Locust Point 4



Adjacent to Federal Hill is Locust Point, a charming peninsula where long-time residents live beside friendly newcomers.

STAR-SPANGLED BANNER Tour Fort McHenry National Monument and Historic Shrine, where Francis Scott Key was inspired to write the national anthem during the War of 1812.

THE SWEETEST SIGN Glowing red each night is the neon "Domino" Sugar" sign, a Baltimore icon erected in 1951 as the emblem of the almost 100-year-old Domino Sugar Refinery.

# Little Italy 6

Stroll through the charming streets of Little Italy, and you'll come across dozens of restaurants mingled with rowhouses where families have lived for generations.

THE FOOD Germano's Piattini (which also has an active cabaret) and Da Mimmo's serve generous portions at affordable prices; Ciao Bella and Sabatino's serve up classic dishes. Fine dining options include Aldo's Ristorante and La Tavola.

YEAR-ROUND BOCCE Bocce ball is a favorite pastime for players and spectators, with active leagues all summer. In the fall and winter, there is an inside bocce court at La Scala Restaurant.

#### Ionestown 7



Nearby Jonestown was an early settlement. Today, it's filled with memorials paying homage to that history: Jewish Museum of Maryland, Reginald F. Lewis Museum of Maryland African American History & Culture and the iconic Shot Tower.

FAMOUS STOPS Take in the Star-Spangled Banner Flag House, where the first American flag was made, and the Carroll Mansion, home to one of Maryland's founding families.

#### Canton 8



The heart of this waterfront neighborhood is a quaint village square rimmed with restaurants, pubs and shops along O'Donnell Street.


WATERFRONT PARK Between Boston Street and the Baltimore Harbor, Canton Waterfront Park offers eight acres of harbor views, green space, multi-use trails, Chesapeake Bay access and a boat ramp - ideal for outdoor recreation and community events.

#### **BAR AND RESTAURANT HOPPING**

Canton restaurants and nightlife can satisfy any taste, including seafood, Mexican, sushi, Thai and great pub grub. O'Donnell Square is one of the top places for a night out.



### Fell's Point 9



NEW HOT SPOT The luxurious and modern Sagamore Pendry Baltimore Hotel opened in 2017 atop the restored historic Recreation Pier.

**TOURS FOR EVERY TASTE** Fell's Point offers fun and informational tours for every interest, from ghosts to history to food.

MARITIME HISTORY Delve into Baltimore's African American seafaring history at Frederick Douglass-Isaac Myers Maritime Park, located in one of the city's oldest waterfront buildings.

### Brewers Hill 10



Brewers Hill gets its name from the landmark breweries that once called the area home: National Brewery and Gunther Brewing. You'll know you're there when you spot the winking Mr. Boh at the top of a tower where National Bohemian (or Natty Boh) was once brewed.

**HOT SPOT** Gunther & Co. makes the most of its renovated brewery boiler room as a backdrop to its contemporary cuisine.



## Highlandtown 11



Eclectic Highlandtown is a hub of artistic activity, with artists' studios, community theater companies, street art and Creative Alliance, a multi-use performance, gallery and workshop space.

A WALK IN THE PARK On six acres of green space surrounded by four neighborhoods, Patterson Park almost always buzzes with people walking dogs, feeding ducks at the pond and enjoying the park's playgrounds, pools and athletic fields.

Southwest Baltimore



## Bromo Arts & Entertainment District/Downtown West 1


This area, just north of Camden Yards and the Convention Center, takes its name from the iconic Bromo Seltzer Arts Tower, a part of the Baltimore skyline since 1911. Nearby are theaters, music venues and a centuries-old market to explore.

**TOWER OF ART** Built by the inventor of the headache remedy Bromo Seltzer, the tower today houses the Emerson/Maryland Glass Museum with the world's largest collection of the iconic blue glass bottles and 15 floors of art and studios. Visitors can tour the clock room on Saturdays to see the largest four-dial gravity-driven non-chiming clock in the world.

MARKET VALUE Founded in 1782, Lexington Market is the oldest continuously operating market in America. Visitors and locals savor their favorites - Faidley's Seafood, Berger's Bakery and Connie's Chicken and Waffles, to name a few.

NIGHT AT THE THEATER Check out the latest from Broadway at The Hippodrome or take in a timeless classic by area professionals at Everyman Theatre.

POESIGHTS West of the arts venues, explore Edgar Allan Poe's life, and death, at The Edgar Allan Poe House and Museum and the gravesite at Westminster Hall and Burying Ground.



#### Mount Vernon 2




Mount Vernon is the cultural heart of the city and a National Landmark Historic District. What were once grand mansions of the 19th century are now museums, shops, restaurants and boutique hotels.

#### MONUMENTAL OCCASION

Climb 227 stairs to the top of the Washington Monument, the first dedicated to America's first president, for sweeping views of the city.

THE LIBRARY Home to more than 300,000 books and featuring five tiers of ornamental cast-iron balconies, the George Peabody Library is considered one of the most beautiful libraries in

EAT WELL The Owl Bar at The **Belvedere** is a historic speakeasy where literary legends such as F. Scott Fitzgerald and H.L. Mencken once imbibed. A newer version is The Brewer's Art, home to excellent local brews. Go fancier at Magdalena or Sotto Sopra.



## Pigtown/ Washington Village **3**

Pigtown, also known as Washington Village, draws its name from its early days, when butchers and meatpackers thrived and the animals that arrived by train ran through the streets on their way to market.

TAKE A TRAIN Ride along the first mile and a half of track laid in America at **The B&O Railroad Museum**. One block north, you can learn about those who built the railroad at the Irish Railroad Workers Museum, established in rowhouses where the workers lived.

HISTORIC HOME Part of the mid-18th century estate of Charles Carroll, the Mount Clare Museum House is open to the public for tours. Carroll Park, the surrounding green space, includes athletic fields, a skateboard park and a nine-hole golf course.

CHECK OUT Main Street Washington Boulevard is Pigtown's main commercial district, a lively mix of traditional shops and new businesses. Pick up unique clothing and accessories at Ripp'd Canvas, 9/10 Shoes and 2 Chic Boutique.



## Cherry Hill 4

Cherry Hill is a waterfront neighborhood in South Baltimore, home to the factory that makes Baltimore's famous Berger Cookies.

ROW, ROW, ROW The Baltimore Rowing & Resource Center is a launch point for kayaking and canoeing sightseeing tours. Dock at one of the nearby waterfront bars for a quick break.



## Stadium Area/Ridgely's Delight 5

Baltimore is one of few cities with two major sports stadiums downtown. The area surrounding the homes of the Orioles and Ravens is full of bars and restaurants, perfect for pre-or post-game fun.

FOR THE LOVE OF BASEBALL Considered one of the most beautiful ballparks in the country, Camden Yards is a great stop even if it isn't baseball season. Daily tours take visitors into the dugout, press box and club level. Not far away in Ridgely's Delight is the Babe Ruth Birthplace and Museum, located in the rowhouse where The Babe was born.

AIN'T THE BEER COLD A game day hot spot is Pickles Pub for Maryland staples like crab fries and crab dip-topped burgers paired with Natty Boh.

### Gateway South 6

Just off the highway as you enter the city, Gateway South welcomes you to Baltimore. Try your hand at poker at Horseshoe Casino. Or for something less high stakes, Game is a sports bar with air hockey, arcade games, ping pong and more.

**CELEBRITY NOSH** Horseshoe Casino features local restaurateurs, as well as celebrity chefs, including TV super chefs Gordon Ramsay, Giada De Laurentiis, and Guy Fieri.

## Northwest Baltimore





This neighborhood, which lines the historic Pennsylvania Avenue, was once the epicenter of Baltimore's African American community and a thriving entertainment scene. Jazz clubs and performance halls in the area, notably the Royal Theater, once welcomed performers such as Billie Holiday, Cab Calloway and Louis Armstrong. Take a guided tour with Baltimore National Heritage Area to learn more about the rich history and culture of this neighborhood.


ON A ROLL Opened in 2011, the Avenue Bakery has developed quite a following, particularly for "Poppay's Rolls," named for the proprietor and baker who makes the buttery soft rolls just like his mother did. While here, check out the murals and memorabilia depicting African American history in Baltimore.

## Druid Hill Park 3

A 745-acre urban oasis in the heart of Baltimore, Druid Hill Park opened in 1860 and is home to a public pool preparing for a multi-million-dollar upgrade, two disc golf courses and tennis courts. It's a great place for a walk or run, bike ride or nature photo shoot.

WALK ON THE WILD SIDE The Maryland Zoo in Baltimore is the third oldest zoo in the country and home to chimpanzees, giraffes, elephants and polar bears. The award-winning Penguin Coast gets you closer to African penguins than ever before.

BLOOMIN' BEAUTIFUL The Howard Peters Rawlings Conservatory and Botanic Gardens, a Victorian "Glass Palace," is always in bloom. Stop in to smell the roses, orchids or tropical greenery in different environments.



## Bolton Hill 2



Bolton Hill is a lovely neighborhood of stately 19th-century homes and green spaces. Within its boundaries is the Maryland Institute College of Art. Among its famous residents were F. Scott Fitzgerald and Woodrow Wilson.

CIVIL RIGHTS ICON Tour the Lillie Mae Carroll Jackson Museum at the former Baltimore NAACP president's beautifully restored home.





## Hampden 4

Once a 19th-century mill town, Hampden is an eclectic shopping and dining haven. Hampden's hub is 36th Street, also known as The Avenue, with restaurants, vintage and antique stores and coffee shops. The neighborhood is also known for its fun-loving festivals and a proclivity to decorate lavishly for holidays, especially Christmas, when "The Miracle on 34th Street" lights up.

**TAKE A STROLL** The Avenue is great for browsing and for serious shopping. Among the locally owned shops are Ma Petite Shoe, Trohv, Brightside Boutique and Milagro. Keep your eyes peeled for local street art.

FOODIES, TAKE NOTE If you aren't hungry when you arrive, you'll work up an appetite surveying all the lunch and dinner spots. The Food Market, Cafe Hon and Wicked Sisters are some of the options.

THE SWEETEST PLACES For an anytime delight, sample the ice cream at The Charmery, the candy at Charm City Chocolates or indulge in a happy hour cocktail at The Blue Bird Cocktail Room.

**COLLECTIVE FUN** Independent businesses, including a coffee roaster, pizza haven and rock-climbing mecca, join Union Craft Brewing's brewery and taproom at the Union Collective in this renovated space under the Jones Falls Expressway.

## Reservoir Hill 7

Reservoir Hill is a largely residential neighborhood with mostly late-19th to early-20th century row houses. The district also includes grand mansions and multi-story apartment buildings, a handful of religious and commercial buildings and public monuments.

SIT AND ENJOY The Dovecote Café's creed may be "community first, café second," but the coffee and pastries are no afterthought.

### Westside 5



Beyond downtown, Westside Baltimore is a largely residential area encompassing more than 20 neighborhoods and includes one of the largest woodland parks, **Gwynns Falls/Leakin Park**. The 15mile Gwynns Falls Trail connects much of west and southwest Baltimore to this greenspace and provides ideal spots for hiking, biking, skateboarding and other outdoor activities.

NATURAL HABITAT The Carrie Murray Nature Center includes a live display of reptiles and amphibians and an Insect Zoo with hundreds of species.

## Woodberry 6



This working-class enclave is coming on strong as a trendy place to live and hang out. Woodberry's development is largely along the Jones Falls in a valley below Hampden, where former mills and factories are becoming loft apartments, high-end restaurants, brew pubs and artist studios.

**CULINARY EXPLOSION** The awardwinning restaurant Woodberry Kitchen began the Woodberry renaissance; now, you'll have quite a choice to make: Birrotecca, LaCuchara, Cosima. You may need more than one trip!



## Northwest Baltimore

## Mount Washington 8

Nestled in the northwestern nook of Baltimore, Mount Washington is famous for its historic charm and diverse housing that exudes the warm qualities of the old-world summer getaway. The village's boutiques, salons, galleries, restaurants and cafes are set amid wooded hills and old trees.

SHOP AND DINE Check out the clubby bar or the manywindowed dining room at Mount Washington Tavern for cocktails and traditional Maryland fare. After your meal, stroll around the surrounding shops of Mount Washington Village and the nearby Mount Washington Mill.

Specialty shops and small restaurants make this a pleasant, low-key shopping destination, especially for women's fashion and gifts.

ALWAYS TIME FOR COFFEE Donna's, a Baltimore staple, operates a full restaurant with a popular brunch. But if you only have time for coffee, it's worth a stop.

### Pimlico 11



This community has been home to generations of families and some of the city's busiest synagogues.

GOOD BET The neighborhood's claim to fame is The Preakness Stakes, the second leg of American horseracing's Triple Crown, run each May at Pimlico Race Course.



## Northeast Baltimore



### Station North A&E District 1

North of Penn Station is Baltimore's first state-designated Arts & Entertainment District, an eclectic area of restored and repurposed buildings and performance venues.

STREET ART Open Walls Baltimore is an outdoor exhibit of 38 murals and installations by internationally renowned street artists.

ARTS HUB There's always something happening at Motor House, once Maryland's first Ford dealership, now transformed into a multi-purpose arts venue. Behind it is a constantly changing open-air canvas, Graffiti Alley.

SHOWTIME The beautifully restored Parkway Theatre shows independent films daily and hosts the annual Maryland Film Festival.

## Homewood 2

3

Homewood includes the sprawling **Johns** Hopkins University campus with its quads and imposing buildings, including the 1801 Federalstyle Homewood Museum, a brick-andmarble home that inspired the architecture for much of the university's campus.

**DIFFERENT TASTES** Plan a visit to the Baltimore Museum of Art with a stop at Gertrude's, serving Chesapeake Bay cuisine inside the museum with views of the Sculpture Garden.

### East Baltimore 3



Made up of several small residential areas, East Baltimore is home to many notable institutions and attractions such as Morgan State University, Johns Hopkins Hospital, and Clifton Park, which includes the Clifton Mansion, the former summer home of Johns Hopkins.

HEROES & HEROINES Historical figures and contemporary personalities nearly come to life at The National Great Blacks in Wax Museum on North Avenue.


## Charles Village 4/Remington 5

Just steps from Johns Hopkins University, Charles Village has a vibrant commercial area on St. Paul Street. Next door to Charles Village is up-and-coming Remington, which has seen a recent development boom, including R. House, a modern food hall.

THE PAINTED LADIES Take a drive or walk through Charles Village and get a lift from the brightly colored Victorian-style rowhouses. Inspired by homes in San Francisco, these houses sport an array of colors and styles that show off Baltimore's spunky side.

BLACK WALL STREET African American-owned businesses flourish on the upper blocks of Charles and St. Paul streets, known as Black Wall Street. Visit Terra Café for delicious food and a convivial setting with a full breakfast menu and favorites such as jerk chicken and yams with pineapple.

PIECE OF CAKE Chef Duff Goldman and his team of cake decorators put Charm City Cakes on the map while starring on Food Network's "Ace of Cakes." You can order a cake, take a class or even send your child to a summer program.





Bygone At the Bygone, a roaring '20s-style restaurant atop the Four Seasons, the staff embodies the decadence of the era with a formal dress code, exceptional service and top-notch menu items. Order the duck Flambé, Wagyu Beef Rotisserie or the Baked Alaska and each will be rolled out on a cart and flame-cooked at your table.

**Minnow** Bartenders at this South Baltimore seafood spot have elevated classic cocktails to new heights. A local fan favorite is "Velvet Underground," a magical twist on the traditional Old Fashioned for which bartenders infuse the spirits with applewood smoke under a glass dome just before serving.

**Black Olive** This restaurant serves the finest seafood and Greek dishes daily, but its real specialty is the fish prepared whole. Select a Mediterranean sea bass or another catch from the display on ice at the center of the restaurant, and your selection will be filleted tableside and served with the restaurant's simple (but outstanding) house-made sauce.

## Rec Pier Chop House

At this Italian restaurant inside the Sagamore Pendry Hotel, servers chop and dress the classic Caesar salad tableside on a wheeled cart. The theatrics alone are reason enough to order it, but the taste of tangy parmesan, fresh romaine and savory anchovies will renew your passion for this old standby.

## The Bluebird Cocktail Room

This Hampden hot spot channels '50s cocktail culture with Tiki Thursday. The menu of tropics-inspired drinks changes weekly, but flamed garnishes and quirky serving mugs are guaranteed.
