

# Compassion Has a New Name One that reflects a framework of supportive care

Davie County has always been one of the top North Carolina counties where residents utilize hospice care services. This means that the people of Davie County are well informed about hospice care, understand the benefits of personalized compassionate care, and know how to ask for — and access — the care they want and deserve at end of life.

Although our name — Trellis Supportive Care — is new, we have been your hometown hospice for nearly 40

years. We changed our name from Hospice & Palliative CareCenter for a number of reasons. A primary reason was that many hospices have similar names; and too many families were frustrated because they had unknowingly enrolled with a different hospice organization, believing that they were under our care. Our previous name was a bit generic, as well.

The name *Trellis* was selected because it is a word that beautifully reflects the **framework of support** we provide for patients and families. Adding *Supportive Care* to our name also helps communicate the other services we provide, such as grief counseling, advance care planning, and complementary therapies.

the care that we provide. It's all grounded in support and leading towards comfort, whatever that means to our patients and families, and so Trellis really makes sense to me."

Mary Lyles, MD: "I'm one of many referring physicians to this hospice and I'm very excited about this change, mainly because it's a

more precise definition of all they do. It does not center on end-of-life care only. In my personal experience of seeing one of those teams in action, it reaffirmed for me what a unique service this is, and one that we need more people, our neighbors, anybody, to know that when things get very rough, it is not the end of the plan."

Trellis Supportive Care is the same independent, non-profit, mission driven organization our community has trusted for nearly 40 years, and we will here for generations to come. The only thing that changes is our name. Stop by our Mocksville office anytime to learn more.

**Freda Redmond:** "I know that a lot of times patients and families don't truly understand which hospice is coming to care for them. So with this new name, they can be sure they are with us."



## Pony Club Where it all Begins!



Harnessing the passion of the equestrian sport is just what Yadkin Valley Hounds Pony Club (YVHPC) set out to do over 40 years ago. As one of the one of the oldest Pony Clubs in the Carolina Region of United States Pony Clubs (USPC), it has grown into a club that continues to develop well-rounded horsemen and strong, lasting friendships. What's the secret to YVHPC's 40 years of success? Its connecting kids with a similar passion while inspiring leadership, confidence and sportsmanship.





If you were to come across one of the club's monthly mounted meetings, you'd see a group of kids grooming and tacking up their horses in preparation for their instruction; advanced members assisting younger, more inexperienced members, and the joy in being with horses and each other. The heart of Pony Club is experiencing and enjoying horses and friends.

#### **Building Confidence and Independence**

With members ranging in age from 4 – 25 years old, the lessons learned through YVHPC will carry an individual throughout his or her life. The children learn to have confidence in themselves and others. All of the competitions, rallies and championships are teambased and knowing there is someone there for you is special. A sense of independence comes from the children being responsible for the care of their horse and the management of that horse — knowing how to handle not only the horse, but themselves with the horse. YVHPC is also a healthy outlet for kids, keeping them focused on goals and how to achieve them.

#### **Bringing Up Riders of All Levels**

There are many groups and programs teaching riding skills, but YVHPC is different for sure. With members from five different NC counties (Forsyth, Davie, Iredell, Davidson and Rowan Counties), YVHPC focuses their educational programs on teaching riding skills, horse-care fundamentals and team participation for a wide range of riding levels. "The more advanced riders take on leadership roles to assist the less experienced, which helps everyone develop an understanding of true sportsmanship. The interactions among these riders of different ages and different skill levels creates an environment of acceptance and support. It's just the

to practice their riding skills and study their horse management information. They learn as much from each other as they do from adult instructors," said Twig Mather, a parent and club ratings organizer.

#### Adventures in **Horse Sports**

In the monthly mounted clinics hosted by YVHPC, the focus is mainly on dressage, show jumping and eventing. In addition, there is instruction

and competitive opportunities in other areas, such as foxhunting, mounted games, quiz, polocrosse, vaulting and tetrathlon, which adds to the enjoyment of all equestrian sports. YVHPC welcomes anyone interested in learning more about Pony Club. Join the fun!

#### **USPC Standards of Proficiency**

In order to achieve the goals of USPC, the Standards of Proficiency are used to provide a core curriculum for riders. These standards are incorporated into all YVHPC activities whether it's mounted or unmounted so the learning is fun and experiential. The ratings the children receive are given to recognize their achievements and encourage confidence and independence. "We have ratings several times a year to accommodate the different skill levels, and it's great to see the kids working together

Times have certainly changed when you compare the holidays of yesteryear to those of today. Take a walk down memory lane here in Davie County and imagine what was typical during November and December of 1950.

In 1950, the November issues of The Mocksville Enterprise had many advertisements, much like current day media. Blackwelder-Smoot Store on Wilkesboro Street featured food items for the holidays. Martin Brothers Store near the depot, listed an ad for a deep freezer so that you wouldn't have to stand in line at the freezer locker building. C.J. Angell Appliance Store on North Main Street was selling a Crosley TV for \$209.95. Heffner and Bolick's Grocery ("on the square") advertised a pound of cranberries for 21 cents, a dozen oranges for 29 cents, and turkeys for the holidays at 59 cents per pound. Western Auto Store advertised a layaway now plan with a promise to deliver the items to you on Christmas Eve. It was located at the inner southwest corner of the square. There was also a Firestone Store, a BF Goodrich Store ("home of Santa Claus") on Salisbury Street, C.C. Sanford on the square, and a Wallace dime store near the square. All had ads for popular Christmas gifts. Another paper that was available during this time. The Davie Record, had similar ads for holiday food and Christmas gifts.

Shopping during the holidays during this time period was very different. A time before credit cards. people were required to plan their purchases carefully and advance. Lavawav plans were vital. Since this was just five years after the end of World War II, residents were still remembering lean times with rationing and gifts seemed to be of the practical sort.

Entertainment was different in 1950, too. The Princess Theatre had four different movies per week. The Davie Drive-in Theatre (near the present community college) had space reserved for trucks, with double features on Friday and Saturday nights. Most places seemed to be closed on Sundays.

Wilkins Drug Store on the Square was the Greyhound Bus Station and advertised prices for 'coming home for Christmas'. A bus ride from New York City cost \$11.25.

The holidays of the past seemed much less involved than current celebrations. It was a different way of life 68 years ago.

### New Name Reflects Agency's Mission to Prevent Violence


Davie Domestic Violence Services and Rape Crisis Center announced its new name on September 26, 2018. The new name is **Davie Center for Violence Prevention**. The new name and logo continues to reflect the agency's mission to end domestic violence and sexual assault through crisis intervention, advocacy, resources, education, and support services.

Susannah Anderson, a survivor of domestic violence, is just one example of why the agency exists. "My story is about hope," Anderson said. "Never stop sharing hope. Even when they (victims) pretend not to care, keep offering hope."

Because of clients such as Susannah, the center and its staff seek to reduce the incidence of family violence in Davie County through early and appropriate intervention and direct services to victims of domestic violence and sexual assault. The services provided to victims and their family members include: crisis intervention, advocacy, accompaniment to court and/or the magistrate's office, assistance with filing legal documents (e.g. 50-B, motions), referrals to law enforcement agencies, counseling, local community resources, coordination of emergency shelter, and a 24 hour crisis intervention and victim assistance hotline.

Davie Domestic Violence Services was formed on June 13, 1994. Throughout its history, the agency has received funding from the following sources: NC Council for Women, Domestic Violence, Marriage License, Sexual Assault, and Divorce Fees; Governor's Crime Commission, Victims of Crime Act; NC Department of Health and Human Services, Family Violence Prevention Services Act, and Rape Prevention Education; Z. Smith Reynolds Foundation, Duke Endowment Foundation, Pearls of Empowerment and Davie County United Way.

Davie Center for Violence Prevention is a county agency under the Health and Human Services umbrella. Lisa Ivester serves as Director of Davie Center for

Violence Prevention. "We wanted our name and logo to more accurately reflect the mission. The new name is more welcoming and supportive, and speaks to our renewed commitment to prevent violence in our community by offering core services in Crisis Intervention, Advocacy, Resources, Education, and Support Services," said Lisa Ivester.

Davie Center for Violence Prevention currently has four full time staff members. Trained volunteers assist with crisis intervention, the crisis line, outreach and prevention programs, support groups and office assistance. ## Strong Community Partnerships

### Strengthen Behavioral Health Services in Davie County

Many of our friends, neighbors, and family members throughout Davie County are living with mental illness, tackling substance abuse or require support for intellectual or developmental disabilities so they can lead richer, fuller lives.

Perhaps you or a loved one could benefit from treatment for a mental health condition, substance use disorder or intellectual/developmental disability but don't have Medicaid or private insurance coverage. In Davie County, you simply call toll-free 1-800-939-5911 to reach Cardinal Innovations Healthcare and arrange an appointment with a service provider in Davie County.

Caring for people is what we do best here at Cardinal Innovations. We work closely with the community of service providers who offer treatment to those with behavioral health conditions and are here to help you find the best support services to meet your needs.

#### **Changes in Public Behavioral Health**

If you have Medicaid or no insurance at all, we'll work with you to coordinate behavioral health services at no cost to you throughout our Triad region, which includes Davie, Forsyth, Stokes and Rockingham Counties, and throughout our 20 county service area in North Carolina, as needed.

As someone who has worked with the Triad region for many years, it's been incredibly rewarding to witness change in the public behavioral health system throughout my career. Many years ago, community mental health centers provided behavioral health services in each county. Changes in the public system mean that individuals now have more options in selecting a service provider, with more and better services available.

In fact, building a strong local presence is something at which our Community Operations staff works really hard. We're the 'boots on the ground', establishing relationships with local leaders and agencies to understand community needs and work together to improve services and supports available to our members.

Throughout my time working with the Triad region, those community partnerships have grown in key ways. For instance, a monthly Davie Community Partners meeting brings together leaders from county management, Davie Departments of Social Services and Public Health, law enforcement, EMS/Emergency Services, hospitals, schools, probation and parole and non-profit human service agencies. Every fourth Wednesday of the month, participants gather at the Davie Wellness Center to share information, coordinate existing resources in the county, identify local needs and problem-solve solutions.

#### **Working Together**

Community groups are also working together to improve services for children in foster care. Davie

County management, the Department of

Social Services and Cardinal Innovations have created a proposal for a new child services initiative to reduce trauma and multiple moves for children in foster care by increasing training and support for foster families during times of crisis. Some funds for the initiative have already been identified and there is strong legislative interest that could make the initiative a reality in Davie and the other Triad counties in the near future.

Community collaborations will become even more critical as Medicaid and the public behavioral health system undergo reform beginning in 2019. While many positive changes are expected, such as "whole-person"

integrated medical and behavioral health care, there is little doubt that strong community

partnerships are essential for a smooth transition for individuals receiving services.

Although I am retiring at the end of this year, I am confident that the strong community partnerships in Davie County will lead to an even stronger behavioral health system. We can do this together!

It just takes a community.





Smart Start of Davie County is passionate about providing early childhood resources to all children in the county regardless of demographics. Smart Start was established in North Carolina in 1993 after it was determined that children were coming to school unprepared to succeed. Smart Start of Davie County recognized the innovative thinking and research behind education starting at birth and became a partner in the Smart Start Network in November 1997. After serving children for over 20 years, Davie County's local partnership is more determined than ever to ensure that learning starts at birth. After all, parents are the first and most powerful teacher in a child's life.

Research shows that the earliest years of childhood are critical. Experiences during this time literally shape the structure of the brain. Smart Start of Davie County offers programs that focus on building relationships with the children's parents, caregivers, guardians and child-care workers to promote meaningful learning.

Smart Start of Davie receives state funds to provide services to the community at little or no cost. As dollars are reduced and costs increase, fundraising is essential

to grow our programs and strengthen our community. In 2019, Smart Start of Davie County will host the **8th Annual Hometown Hoedown at WinMock at Kinderton**. This is a fun filled night of genuine people giving to ensure the earliest learners in Davie County receive a "smart start". A presenting sponsor that believes in our mission has been secured for the evening. Other sponsorship opportunities are available. The event sells out every year and tickets can be secured online or by calling our office.

Through generous supporters and grantors, Smart Start of Davie County has increased our positive impact on the community in the past year. DavieLiFE had the opportunity to spend some time with this year's Davie County Schools Teacher of the Year back in October. We had such a good time capturing this sweet family in photographs and learning a bit more about Dawn Lowery who is no stranger to Davie County.

Tell us a little about yourself - where you grew up, went to school, your family, etc.

I was blessed to grow up in Davie County. I went to Shady Grove Elementary, North Davie Middle, and then Davie High School. I actually teach 6th grade math in the same classroom where I was a 6th grade math student with Jamie Lyerly. After I graduated from Davie High in 2003, I went to North Carolina State University and obtained a Business Management degree with a Marketing concentration. I lived in Charlotte for a couple of years before moving back to Davie County with my husband, Patrick. We have two wonderful children, Tucker (4) and Berklee (almost 2) and a

basset hound, Polly. My husband built our house in Advance almost three years ago and that is where we currently live.

#### When did you decide to be a teacher?

I knew at a very young age I wanted to be a teacher. I was extremely fortunate to have some very influential teachers and coaches while growing up in this county. I knew that teaching was my calling. But as a young and naive teenager, I let others influence me about what was important in a career. After I graduated from N.C. State, I worked for an advertising company as an Account Manager. It was a very solid job, but it wasn't fulfilling. I knew that God could use me in a much bigger and better way. I wanted to influence young children in the same way that I had been in school. In 2009, I was offered a part-time and long-term substitute position at the Davie County Early College. That was it. I knew I was where I needed to be — in the classroom. I went ahead and took the Praxis in Middle Grade Math. Jennifer Custer called me about three days before open house in 2010 and offered me a fulltime 6th grade math position. I then began my lateral

entry work and became certified a couple of years later. It was a huge leap of faith, but I totally felt that my heart was in teaching. I haven't looked back since.

## What are your thoughts on being named Teacher of the Year for Davie County Schools?

I am completely blown away. In no way do I feel even close to deserving of this honor. There are so many strong educators in our county that I can't even begin to list them all. This entire experience has been very humbling. I'm honored to represent Davie County Schools, but none of this would be possible without the wonderful students that I teach every day, the great staff I work with, and my hometown county that instilled the importance of education in me at a young age. It is no secret that God called me to this career and I couldn't be more grateful.

## What are some ways that you engage your students?

I know math is not everyone's favorite subject. I get that. As much as I wish it was and every student came through my doors saying "teach me more math Mrs. Lowery," that is just obviously not the case. I just try to use different strategies, activities, and tools to keep them engaged. We implement a lot of collaborative learning in class that sometimes takes students out of their comfort zone. But probably most importantly, I try to answer the questions "when am I ever going to



need to use this." I try to relate as much real-world application to my math class as I can. If that's through discussion, videos, Google Classroom, or other avenues, when a student can see or hear of example where this can be used, they often become more connected.

#### You're a middle school teacher. Some may think that is a difficult age to work with on a daily basis, but what are some of your favorite things about middle schoolers?

As much as I knew I wanted to be a teacher, I knew I didn't want to be in middle grades. But since starting this position, I quickly knew that middle school was a perfect fit for me. These kids, especially sixth graders, are just looking for someone to mold them, challenge them, and develop a relationship with them. I love the fact that they come to me in August as babies and leave in June as pre-teens. It is great to see how much

change and growth they can make in one year in sixth grade, and then all the way through eighth grade. I think this is a good age for me to really build relationships and encourage these students, when they may not always get that. If these middle schoolers can leave North Davie knowing that Mrs. Lowery is in their corner, I've done my job.

## You're a mom to two young kids, a full-time teacher and the Davie High softball coach. How do you balance it all?

To me, it is just something that all working moms and wives manage to do. I have surrounded myself with a village that supports me and my family and is always willing to help out when I need them. My husband is my superhero. He is my biggest supporter and does more for our family than I give him credit for, especially during softball season. The spring has a lot of long days and late nights involved, and he is so eager to take the lead with our young kids. When I begin to feel guilty or inadequate as a mom and wife, he is quick to encourage me to continue doing the things I love to do because he knows they make me happy. I could not do all of this without his love and support. I also have wonderful family members and friends that help with the kids when I am tied up somewhere else. With a lot of planning and asking for help, we make it work. We definitely try to be intentional about our time together and that helps keep my cup full!

## Best thing about being able to teach in the community you grew up in?

I love the community I grew up in and simply want to invest in it as much as I can. What a better way to make an impact than with the next generation. We are very




fortunate to live and teach in this community. If students can realize this and not take it for granted, we would see a huge difference in our community. I think I would be a teacher no matter where this job took me, but being back in my hometown makes it extra sweet.

#### How many years have you taught?

This is my tenth year in the classroom. Ninth year at NDMS. I taught one year part-time at the Davie County Early College.

### **Davie Respect Initiative Announces the**

## of the First Davie Respect Challenge



What a wonderful first year for the Davie Respect Initiative (DRI), which closed on October 10, 2018. There were many submitted applications in the DRI challenge, representing all ages from 12 to 21. From that outstanding group, 18 semifinalists were chosen who each had the opportunity to "pitch" their idea to the allvolunteer selection panel. It was a difficult challenge for the panelists to choose only 10 winners from such a great set of ideas. The range of creativity was striking, as the winner's list below will show.

Here are the Winners of the First Annual Davie Respect Challenge:



Jaeline Anguiano (21): The idea behind this project is to create a video web series in which Davie County community members would be interviewed and asked to share about their occupation and career. The video series would be made available to all members of the community through the Internet. This is a perfect project for Davie County

Economic Development and helping to draw the community more together.

**Taylor Bare (17):** Having come to Davie County after five years abroad (military family), this applicant experienced the challenge of entering into a large high school with minimal support. She proposes the development of a group of

"student ambassadors" who would be paired with new students to assist them in settling in at their new school.



Isabella Brown (18): Having a family member become involved with an innovative program in Winston-Salem called Cam's Coffee inspired this applicant to propose that a similar program be developed for the "differently-abled" in Davie County. This would involve developing a coffee house that would primarily be staffed by

young folks with challenges like autism, attention deficit disorder and more.

Morgan Creason (13): This applicant observed, first-hand, the unequal treatment often experienced by minority students when faced with behavioral problems. He proposes that a "student advocacy" council be created that would include students, teachers and school support staff working together to "create a more caring and



understanding school environment for everyone".



Jose Garcia (18): Emphasizing the value of the age-old golden rule, "treat others as you would like to be treated", this project would focus on using art in print and electronic form to post images with the golden rule throughout the community.
