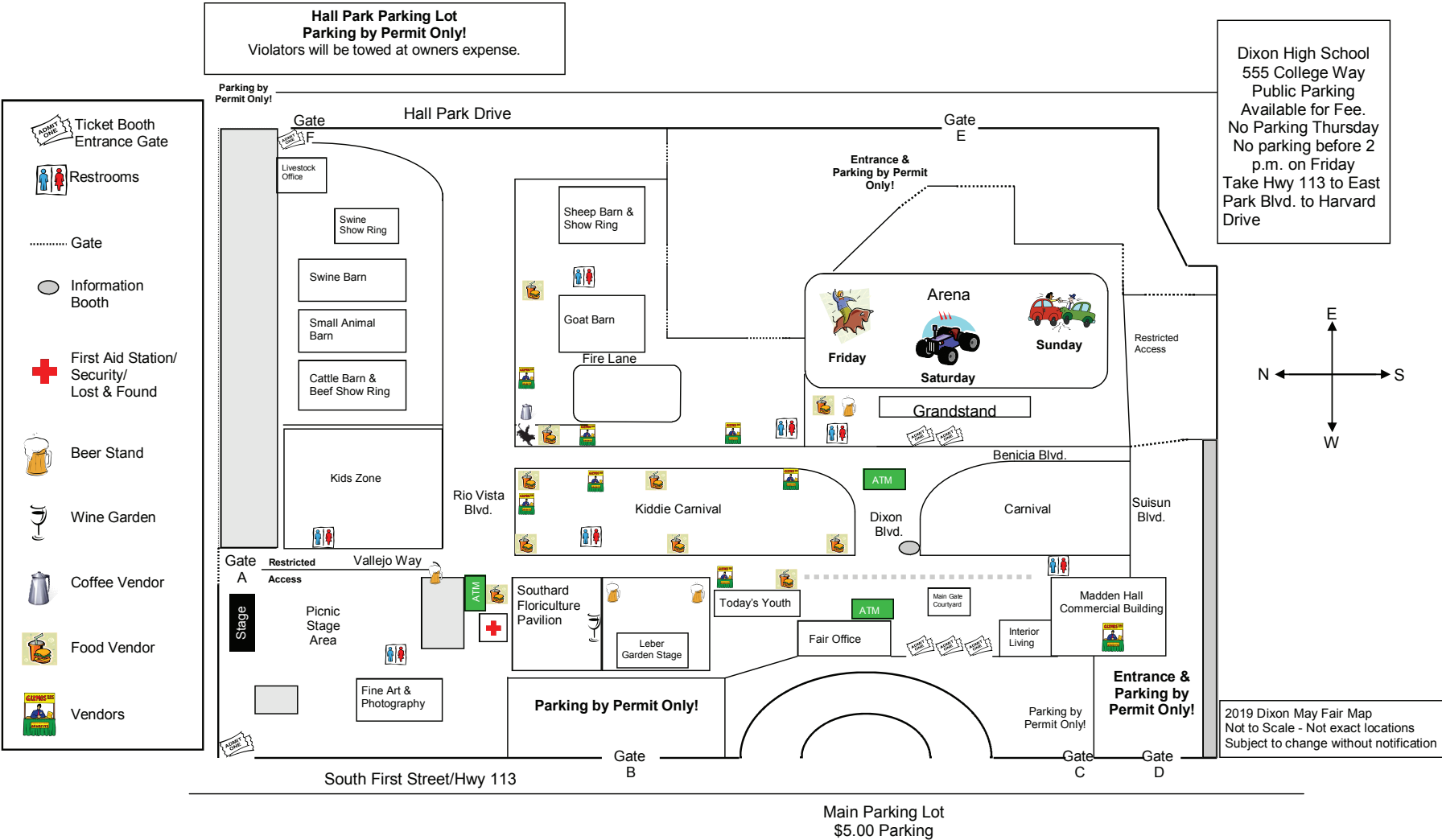

Broncs and Bulls Thrill in the Grandstand Friday Night

Friday night will be an exciting time at the Fair when talented bronc and bull riders take to the Coors Light Grandstand at 7 p.m., presented by West Coast Rodeo Company. Cowboy risk-takers are willing to climb the back of a bucking bronc or notorious bull for a share of the purse or a silver buckle and the ride of a lifetime. 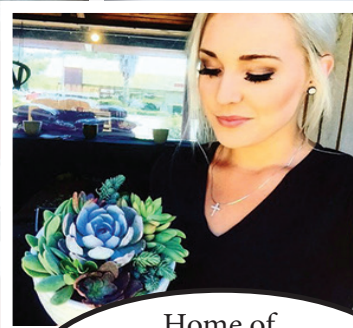

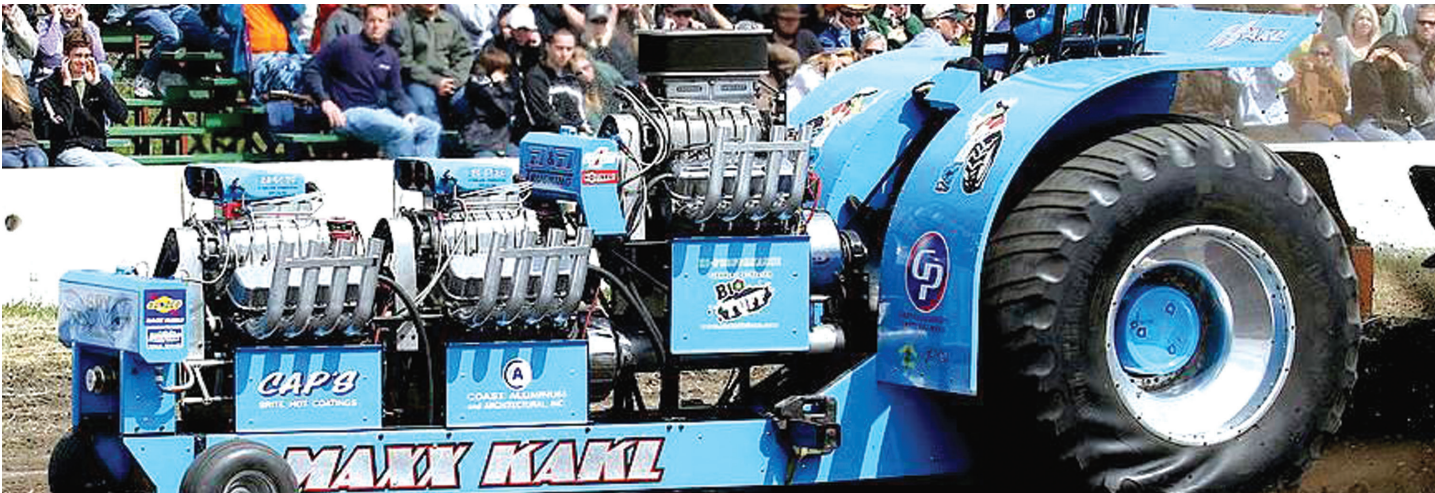


The Truck and Tractor Pulls Roar into the Grandstand Saturday Night
