

The club continues to offer scholarships to high school seniors and young women, to continue their education.

A few of the notable service projects SI Woodland has done in the past are: The "Baby Think It Over" project, in which dolls equipped with computer chips were donated to Yolo County middle and high schools for their health education classes. The goal of the dolls was to reduce teen pregnancies.

The ABC ("A Book for Every Child") Project. During the duration of the project, over five years, more than 600 ageappropriate books were given to Yolo children in County preschool kindergarten, and classes.

Through "College its Bound" program, club members presented a program to thirdgrade students with information about the benefits of attending college. The program included a field trip to the U.C. Davis campus.

The club also held Career Day Workshops for women at Progress House, a half-way house in Woodland.

SI Woodland is part of Soroptimist International of the Americas. an international women's organization that works to improve the lives of women and girls through programs leading to social and economic empowerment.

Founders' Day Award in 2016.


In 2018, Tania challenged incumbent. Angel Barajas, in а campaign to represent District 3 on the City Council. ran She on а "Community First" platform. Her
