Proud to be an Employer of Choice

Since the US military is the largest construction employer, he hopes that local veterans with construction skills will consider Davie Construction as well. “Women hold key management roles at Davie. Our Controller, Greta Gardner, is President of the local Chapter #109 of the National Association of Women in Construction. Mental Health First Aid: Empowering the Community to Care

MAY MARKS THE BEGINNING OF SPRING SHOWERS, blooming flowers, and mental health awareness month.

In some ways it's becoming easier and more common for people to talk about their own mental health, and to empathize with people who are facing mental health concerns.

But there's more work to do.

Successfully erasing the stigma around mental health begins with the recognition that mental illness impacts each one of us. Even if you currently experience excellent mental health, someone you know — a friend, loved one, coworker, or neighbor — may be affected by a mental health issue. Knowing what to say, what not to say, and how to respond when a person needs help can make a difference in their life.

That's why training to increase behavioral health literacy in our community is so important.

Local Training

Here in Davie County, there are many chances for individuals to learn more about mental health. In fact, many classes are free and conveniently taught within our local community, through support trainers from

Cardinal Innovations Healthcare. They are typically designed to engage attendees with lots of activities, like role playing and simulation exercises. These activities show what it's like to face mental health concerns and teach how to help.

The Davie Wellness Center in Mocksville, located at 142 Gaither Street, offers monthly education in a wide range of topics, including mental health awareness. There, you can take free self-care and stress management classes that incorporate art or exercise. You can attend classes that are more educational, like learning how to recognize if an elderly loved one might be considering suicide. You can also learn basic vocational skills or take a class on how to find disability insurance. Although the center is operated by Cardinal Innovations Healthcare, you don't need to be a member or affiliated with Cardinal to participate.

You may also find it interesting to know that mental health first aid training is offered to community support groups in Davie County and other communities across North Carolina. These are much like regular first aid classes, but with an emphasis on how to help someone experiencing a behavioral health crisis, rather than a physical wound. It has been given to school systems, public safety groups (such as police officers and emergency response teams), faith-related groups, and even some of our elected officials. Mental health first aid training enables people to recognize when someone is experiencing a mental health crisis. It equips them with the skills and resources necessary to get people the right support at the right time.

THERE'S NEVER BEEN A BETTER TIME TO LIVE IN DAVIE COUNTY. Those who live here want to stay, as evidenced by the available housing inventory which is down close to 30 percent from this time last year*. Homes in Davie are also seeing an average appreciation of four to eight percent in values.

What does this mean for those hoping to join this vibrant community?

Bob Church, mortgage loan officer at Allegacy Federal Credit Union, advises, "If you're looking to purchase, get completely credit approved before you house hunt. It's a seller's market. Multiple offers are made, especially for houses in the \$150,000 to \$200,000 range. You want to be ready when you find that perfect house and having financing already lined up is a big plus."

Credit approval letters are not the same as a **prequalification**. A prequalification typically means that you would be approved based on verbal information you've provided the lender. This letter will not hold much weight with sellers and listing agents as information is not verified.

With a credit approval letter, the lender collects proof of income (pay stubs/tax returns/W2s), pulls a credit report, and verifies assets. The loan then receives an approval from an automated underwriting engine

from Fannie Mae or Freddie Mac with the terms you are most comfortable. The loan amount and terms can be adjusted once the home is selected. With a credit approval letter, you enter negotiations with financing assured.

Speaking of negotiations, in a seller's market, most houses go for list price and sometimes more. **Current sales are averaging almost 98 percent of list price**, so if you find the house of your dreams, be realistic about the price and truly offer what you're willing to pay. Sellers have worked with their real estate agents to determine a fair market price for the home. Low ball offers tend to stop the process as the seller usually has another offer waiting or knows another will come in soon.

Mortgage rates are still low and Davie County is a great location with its community atmosphere, convenience to world-class health care, restaurants, retail stores, schools and close proximity to Interstate 40. It's easy to understand what draws people here, making the search for the perfect Davie County home worth the time and effort.

Local Partnership Provides **Trauma Information and Training** for Students and Community

OVER THE PAST YEAR AND A HALF, the staff at The Dragonfly House have been working closely with key personnel at Davie County Schools to create a, local, community-specific version of a trauma-informed/trauma-sensitive school and community. This is called **“Compassionate and Resilient Schools”** (CRS), and it is a best-practice, inclusive, trauma-responsive approach to education.

The mission is to show compassion and promote resiliency both in our schools and in our communities. The training teaches with intention, how to build relationships with all students so that childhood trauma can be recognized and prevented. In addition, the training emphasizes the importance of creating safe and nurturing relationships, as well as inclusive environments.

Childhood trauma can have a direct, immediate, and potentially overwhelming impact on children’s ability to learn. The goal is for educators and school professionals to understand the role of trauma, its effect on children and how they can change methods of interacting and responding to these children. By adopting a Compassionate and Resilient approach, schools under-take a shift in perspective at the staff and organizational level to recognize, understand and address the learning needs of children impacted by negative experiences.

What does a CRS do?

“CRS is important because the way we’ve always done things isn’t necessarily what’s best for kids. Kids will do well if they can, and if they aren’t doing well, then it’s our job (as adults) to figure out what is getting in the way,” said Aubrey Draughn, a school social worker for Davie County Schools.

A Compassionate and Resilient School operates much like a wheelchair ramp does for handicap accessibility — it exists for those who we already know need it, it is there for students who may not have been recognized as in need of it, for students who may not need it now but could need it in the future, and those who may not ever need it but having it in place teaches them compassion from modeling the mindset and perspective shift that their peers and teachers display within a CRS framework.

“We teach our students the skills they need to learn to regulate their emotions on their own,” said Draughn. “It’s really a beautiful thing to see students recognize when they need to take a break, practice mindfulness, get up and move around, etc.”

Currently **Mocksville Elementary School** and **South Davie Middle School** are piloting the program in Davie County Schools. DCS has designated through their Strategic Plan that by June 2023, DCS will create and

enhance learning environments that support and prepare students socially and emotionally as measured by annual student and staff surveys, discipline, attendance, dropout data, and counseling data. One strategy for this is to implement a Compassionate and Resilient Schools approach district-wide.

"So far at Mocksville Elementary School, we've seen amazing results. When asked in a survey if students felt they could trust teachers and other school staff, if they felt valued and safe at MES, more students answered 'yes' to all three questions in 2019 than in 2018," said Draughn.

Already, school-based mental health therapists have been contracted through Lorven to help better meet the health needs of students. Additionally, Mocksville Elementary School Principal Jennifer Swofford, South

Mental Health First Aid

Specifically, our mental health first aid classes provide an overview of what mental illness is, how many people it affects, and the signs and symptoms of various mental illnesses. We also talk about where the stigma surrounding mental health comes from. Very often, for example, even the words we use unconsciously contribute to stigmas. For those who are comfortable doing so, we encourage people to share their own experiences. This helps our goal of creating a class environment where the shame and misunderstanding around mental illness can be underscored and debunked.

All of this is meant to offer new understanding. Our hope is that people will discover more positive ways to think and talk about mental illness.

Just as importantly, we teach the five-step **ALGEE** action plan that prepares people to respond if and when they encounter someone who needs assistance. It includes:

- **A**ssess for risk of suicide or harm
- **L**isten non-judgmentally
- **G**ive reassurance and information
- **E**ncourage appropriate professional help
- **E**ncourage self-help and other support strategies

After learning about **ALGEE**, those who attend our mental health first aid classes role-play putting those steps into action. For example, an instructor will pretend to be having a panic attack, and participants will practice asking them questions, calming them, finding out who they can contact, and so on. Doing this gives individuals greater confidence in their skills and abilities to respond in a true crisis situation.

Here at Cardinal Innovations, we're proud of the work we're doing in our communities to raise awareness about mental health. Not just this month, but every month. In fact, in 2017-2018 alone, we offered these kinds of trainings to nearly 11,000 people in North Carolina.

New Faces, New Name, Same Beloved Course

A local favorite returns with a fresh perspective on golf in Davie County

When Hickory Hill opened its doors to members back in 1968, it rapidly became a favorite hangout for nearby families. Locals still reminisce about the hours spent on the golf course, with its gently rolling hills, breathtaking lake views, and tall, swaying pines.

After several decades and an ownership change, the club began to lose some of its luster.

Fast-forward to 2018. That's when David and Sherry Duncan stepped in. The couple purchased a portion of what was Lake Louise Golf Club, while Joel and Beth Edwards own the remaining portion (the Edwards plan to develop a wellness park).

"When we purchased the golf course, we knew right away we wanted the whole community to feel at home here," said David Duncan. "We want families to enjoy the course and special events we'll be planning. We hope church groups will come out on Sunday afternoons and fellowship together. This is also a great place for our local businesses and nonprofits to host an outing."

The Duncans have worked tirelessly for nearly a year to restore the course and clubhouse to its former glory. The course layout has changed a bit during the renovations, but the views are still spectacular.

Now a 12-hole golf course, Colin Creek Golf Club, named after the Duncans' youngest son, offers golfers more options than ever before. Traditionalists can



appreciate a second set of tees on the first six holes. Providing a new angle and distance, the extra tees enable golfers to play a true 18-hole round. Short on time or patience? There's also the option to enjoy six, nine, or 12 holes.

In addition to the improvements made to the golf course, the Duncans have also invested in renovating the clubhouse and building a pavilion. Overlooking the golf course and the lake, the pavilion includes a handsome stone fireplace, iron chandeliers, and ceiling fans, making it the perfect location for private events. The Duncans also own Colin Creek Farm, an elegant wedding venue just across the lake from the golf course.

Group Provides Community Members with Ways to Share Love for Gardening

GARDENING HAS ALWAYS BEEN a skill for some, a hobby for many, a passion for others, but now it's a way to give back to the community for everyone. Whether or not you naturally have a green thumb, you can be an **Extension Master Gardener** volunteer through the North Carolina Cooperative Extension, Davie County Center.

This program began in 1999 and is a partnership with North Carolina State University, North Carolina A&T State University and Davie County local government. The volunteers work hard to bring more education about gardening to those in Davie County as well as beautifying the county.

Some of the projects the Extension Master Gardener Volunteer Association of Davie County has done include: planting and maintaining the pollinator garden at the Town of Mocksville Park, hosting camps for the Junior Master Gardener program of North

Carolina, going into the schools and facilitating activities like Farm Animal Day, and getting their hands dirty in community gardens.

Becoming a Master Gardener is an opportunity for any adult, no matter the skill level or previous experience in gardening. Master Gardener volunteers go through a 40 hour training program where they learn about the different facets of horticulture, botany, soil, insects, specific crops, fruits and vegetables, and more.

"It's pretty comprehensive," Colleen Church, County Extension Director, said. "We touch on a lot of areas that make up the science and study of horticulture."

After the volunteer completes the training program, he or she participates in a 40 hour volunteer internship role and then completes 20 hours each additional year in order to remain a certified master gardener.

Whether they are taking kids fishing, working on projects for the new park, volunteering at the United Way's Day of Caring event or recruiting new members, there are endless opportunities for new

members to get involved and become an Extension Master Gardener volunteer.

"For our extension, we're just here to help people and help the community—I think that's what we all enjoy," Church said.

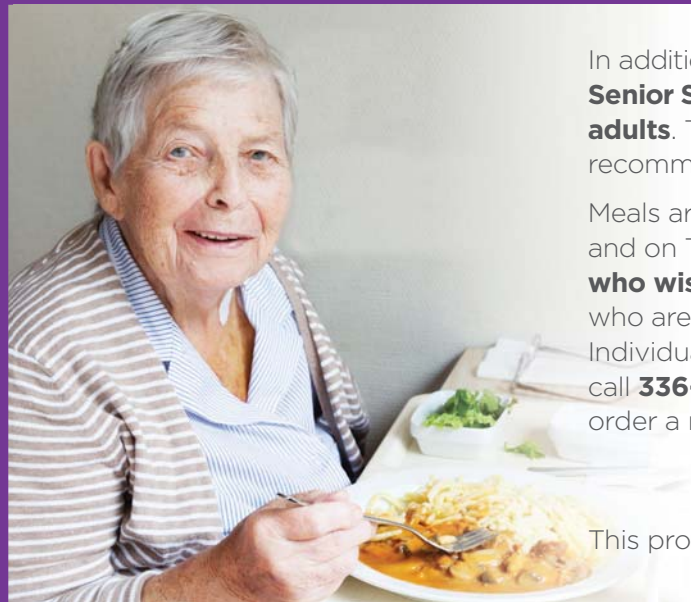
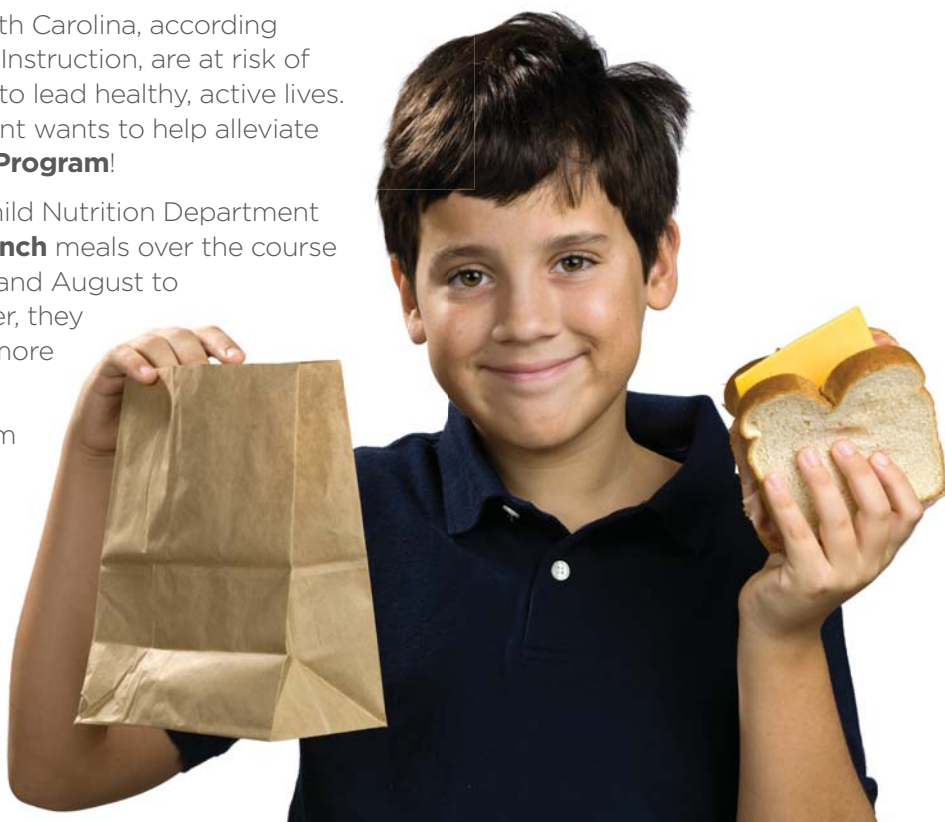
Summer Feeding Programs

Available in the Community

ALMOST 900,000 CHILDREN in North Carolina, according to the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction, are at risk of hunger and not getting the food they need to lead healthy, active lives. The Davie County Child Nutrition Department wants to help alleviate that number through its **Summer Feeding Program!**

In the summer of 2018, the Davie County Child Nutrition Department served **7,147 breakfast** meals and **16,433 lunch** meals over the course of 39 days during the months of June, July and August to children throughout the county. This summer, they hope to surpass those numbers and reach more children in need.

The Davie County Summer Feeding Program will begin on June 17 and conclude on August 9. This program is **FREE to all children ages 1-18**. Central feeding sites include Mocksville Elementary, Cooleemee Elementary, Cornatzer Elementary and William R. Davie Elementary. Many mobile sites will also be available throughout the county. For a full list of feeding sites, please visit the Child Nutrition webpage at **Davie.K12.NC.us**.



In addition to summer feeding programs for children, **Davie County Senior Services** provides a congregate **nutrition program for senior adults**. The program provides a lunch meal which offers 1/3 of the recommended daily dietary allowance to **those 60 and older**.

Meals are available Mondays through Wednesdays at 11:30 a.m., and on Thursdays and Fridays at 11 a.m. **Those 60 and older who wish to fill out paperwork can eat at no charge.** Those who are under 60 or do not wish to fill out paperwork pay \$3.30. Individuals interested in participating in the lunch program must call **336-753-6230 by noon the day before** they plan to eat to order a meal.

Davie County Community Park

FIELD REPORT and Update

The new Davie County Community Park is well under construction. After the Groundbreaking Ceremony held on March 4th, **Davie Construction** began full force on creating the new community park.

While Davie Construction has been leading from the ground, the **Davie County Recreation and Parks (DCRP)** team is working tirelessly to find additional ways to give the community even more than they asked for, and are succeeding.

Through a variety of regional, state and national grants, the DCRP team has been working on gaining additional recreational components to further enhance the park's design as it will be built in Phase 1 of construction. Currently, two grants have been awarded for the park. **The Margaret C. Woodson Foundation Grant** will allow Davie County Recreation and Parks to install an Interactive Outdoor Multi-Sensory Story Book along the trail system being constructed throughout the park. The story book trail will include mounted displays for interchanging books, interpretative geologic nature signs overlooking the

boardwalk observation deck and an array of nature/wildlife interactives to identify native species.

The story book project reaches beyond building vocabulary and opens the door to conversations about important issues like **respect** and **stewardship**. These stories and interactives encourage communication and pique curiosity concerning the natural world. Individuals learn through the sounds, scents and seasons of the outdoors. They make discoveries, deepen common interests and connect their natural curiosity to the wider world.

The second grant awarded to Davie County Recreation and Parks is the **North Carolina Department of Transportation Comprehensive Planning Grant**. This grant will allow the team to complete its first Countywide Comprehensive Master Plan concerning cycling, pedestrian and greenways. This plan will

create opportunities to **enhance connectivity** across public amenities, destination sites and parks.

Most recently, the DCRP Team has submitted a grant application to the **State Parks and Recreation Trust Fund**. If awarded, this grant will allow Phase 1 construction to extend to include additions such as an Elevate Fitness Course, large family shelter, an inclusive playground with Pour N' Place surfacing, and a new greenway loop connector to the campuses of Davie County Community College and the Davie County High School Early College.

As dirt continues to move at the park site, the DCRP Team is working to expand and serve the Davie Community in each aspect of recreation with anticipation of the **new Community Park set to open spring 2020**. 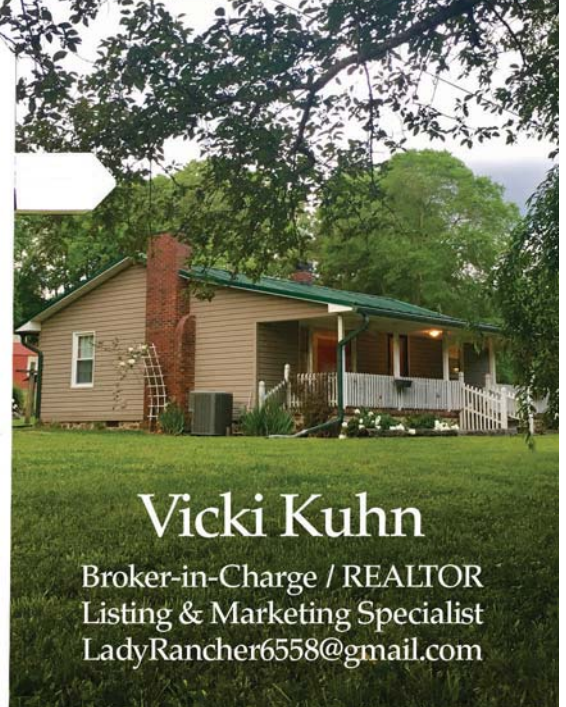

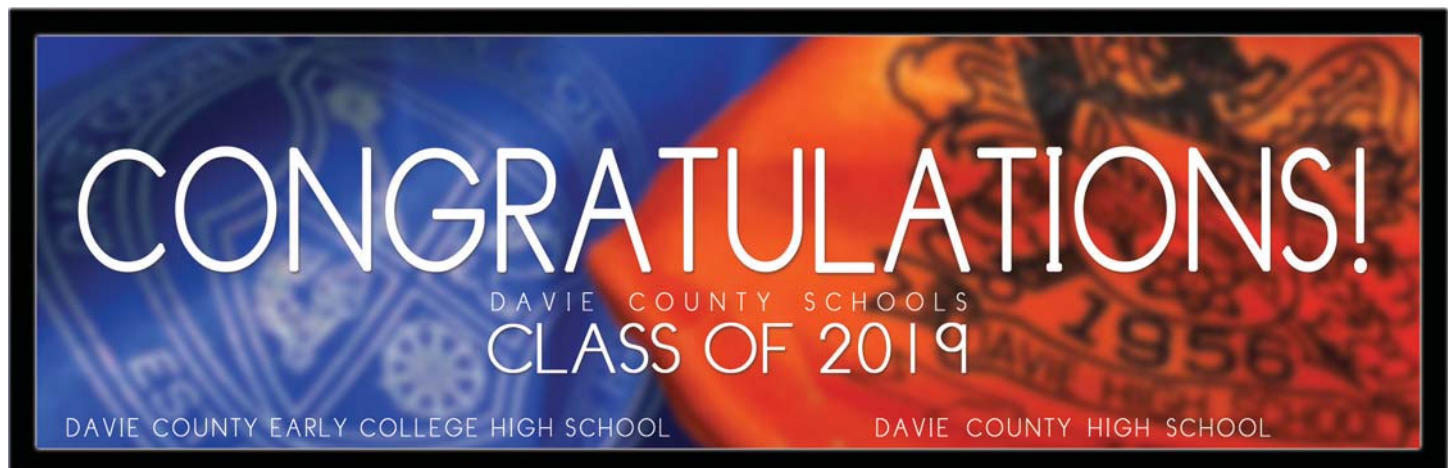

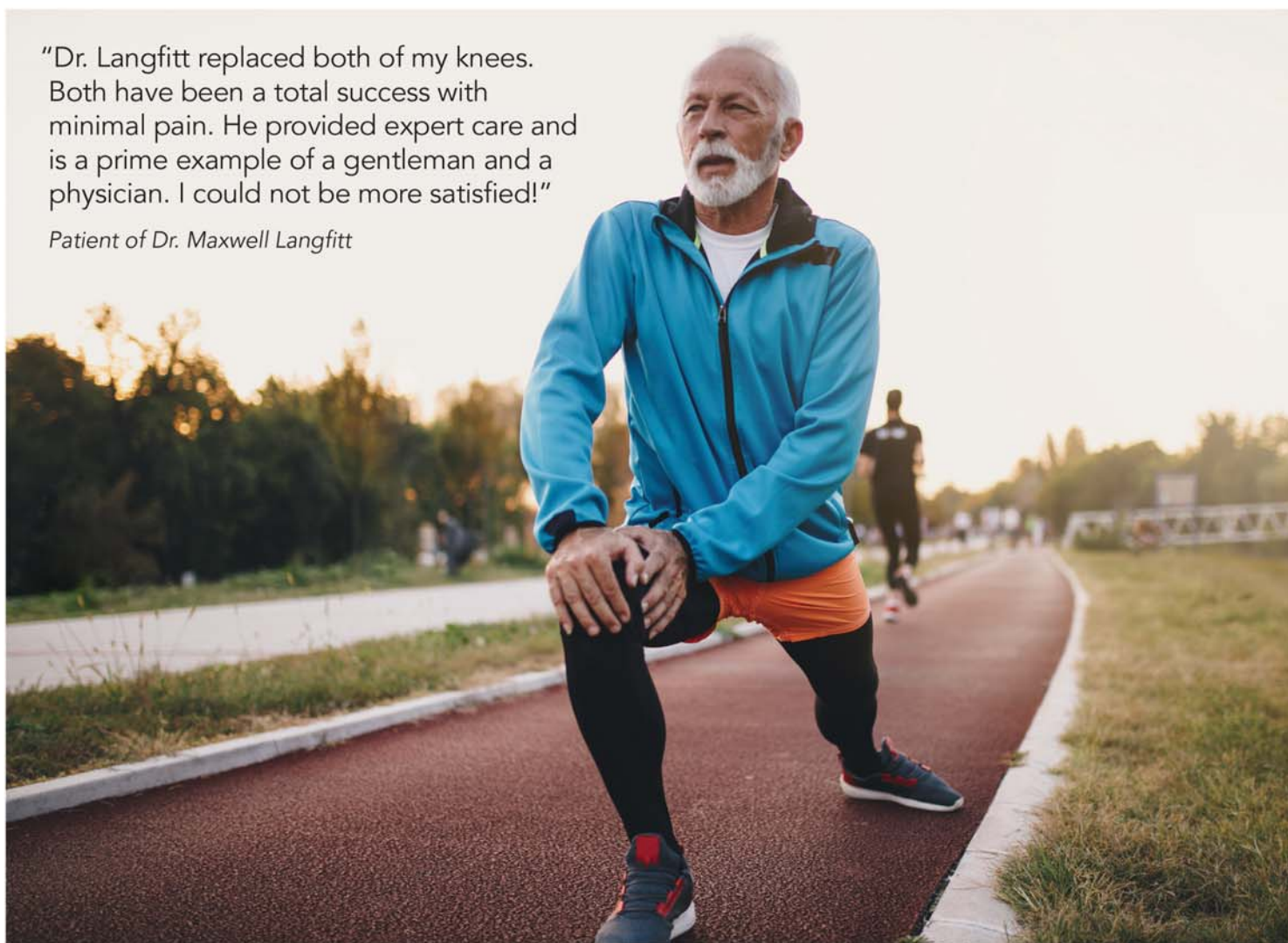
