The program for the 1952 Paradise Festival and Apple Show stated that the fest now known as "Johnny Appleseed Days" was "a gesture of thanksgiving rather than an exposition. It is a family get together to which you the people of the entire area are most cordially and happily invited."

A long-standing favorite of the fest is the Children's Games Plaza, sponsored by Adventist Health and benefitting the Boys and Girls Club. Johnny Appleseed himself will be on hand to tell stories, and face painting will be available in the main vendor area. Continuous entertainment will be provided throughout the two-day fest. Local businesses will be out in force to offer information, demonstrations and promotional materials and gifts. Stop by the Chamber of Commerce booth for business and local information. Artisans and crafters from all over the west will be on hand with unique gifts for early Christmas shoppers and treasure seekers. Visitors and locals may not only partake of the many attractions of Johnny Appleseed Days at Terry Ashe Park on Saturday and Sunday, October 5th and 6th, but may also check out Blues and Brews at Paradise Community Park on Saturday, October 5th. And don't forget your Paradise apple pie! In past years, local volunteers have gathered to bake apple pies from the last orchard on the Ridge to share with the community and guests. This year, while we wait for Noble Orchards to fully recover, the traditional apple pies will be baked in Paradise by Pie Pavilion sponsor Save Mart. Do-it-Yourself pie baking kits, complete with "secret Paradise pie spice mix" will be available for purchase, and community volunteers will serve 1,000 FREE slices of apple pie to attendees as a "thank you" for shelter and assistance during this singular year of change. # Johnny Appleseed Days: Past and Present



The Paradise Ridge Chamber's Johnny Appleseed Days is an historical event enjoyed by scores of attendees each year.

In 1888, Paradise held its first "Harvest Festival" to celebrate the Temperance Society's commandeering of the local saloon. The building was rolled across Clark Road on logs, from what is now Reibes Auto Parts to what is now the Paradise Rite Aid. By 1904, with the introduction of the Butte County Railroad, the Ridge shipped Paradise apples far and wide.

Now known as "Johnny Appleseed Days," our harvest fair is the oldest in the state. For 131 years, the Ridge has showcased agriculture and commerce, and fairs included music, dancing, performances, agricultural prizes, chicken dinners for a quarter, and pageants depicting the gold-rush history of the Ridge. In 1956, the Fair hosted a wedding; guests were Paradise couples who had been married 30 years or more.

The Paradise Ridge Chamber of Commerce began sponsoring the fair in 1937. Hollywood came to Paradise in the form of Errol Flynn and the cast of Robin Hood. 500 people were turned away from Memorial Hall, where the depression-era hottie gave an impromptu speech.

Hollywood's brief appearance on the Ridge gave "The Paradise Fair and Apple Show" the momentum to host The Butte County Fair the following year. This led to the improvement of Clark Road in anticipation of hordes of out-of-town visitors, including Governor Frank Merriam. The Paradise Progress Review of September, 1938 predicted that the "Greatest Fair of All time Will Greet Visitors" and that the celebration would be the "most elaborate fair that has ever been staged on the Ridge." The honor was shortlived, and the County Fair became a movable fest for several years, travelling the region before settling in Gridley after a hard battle lost by the Chamber and other stakeholders.

In 1959, the event was rebranded "Johnny Appleseed Days." Now, as in days of yore, merchants, artisans, peddlers and entertainers travel with their goods to the Fair, although these days it's in a Winnebago instead of a Conestoga.

Staffed almost solely by volunteers, this Paradise event is as much a labor of love as it is a gift to the hundreds of families and community members who enjoy it year after year. According to The Paradise Review of 1940: "No community could have worked any harder nor more whole-heartedly than did the community of Paradise to make past fairs successful."

Through partnerships with sponsors, local talent, and the businesses that are the backbone of our community, we showcase the wealth of activities, attractions, history and beauty that the Paradise Ridge has to offer to both its residents and visitors.


