



VOTER REGISTRATION

To be eligible to register to vote, persons must be at least 18 years old, (17 1/2 to register), not under conviction of a felony, mentally competent, and have been a permanent legal resident of the precinct for 30 days.

- · Voters must register at least 25 days prior to the election.
- · Voters need identification bearing their full legal name (such as birth certificate or driver's license) and current address to reaister.
- · Voters may register at the Board of Elections office or by mail. Voter registration forms may be picked up at any branch of the Wayne County Library system.

AUTO & DRIVING

Driver's License:

- · New residents must obtain a NC driver's license within 60 days of establishing residency.
- · Newcomers must pass a written exam and eye exam. A driving test is given at the discretion of the examiner.
- · Applicants must bring their outof-state license, proof of insurance, proof of address, and proof of social security to the test (Military ID, Social Security Card, or ITIN for proof of social security).
- · Residents moving from within NC must report change of address within 60 days.

· Driver's license must be renewed every five years.

- · New residents must obtain a NC vehicle title at the same time they register their vehicle(s) for license plates.
- · License plates for a passenger vehicle must be purchased within 30 days after establishing residency.

GOLDSBORO

Located in the heart of Wayne County, Goldsborough was incorporated in 1847 and became the county seat. The city of Goldsboro now boasts a population of almost 40,000 and offers all of the amenities of a progressive city. A wonderfully diverse community, Goldsboro is renowned for its many picturesque neighborhoods, historic buildings, family-friendly events and rich heritage.

MOUNT OLIVE

Just to the south of Goldsboro sits the second largest municipality in the county, Mount Olive, offering southern charm and grace at its finest. Mount Olive proudly holds the distinction of being the headquarters of the Mount Olive Pickle Company and is home to University of Mount Olive, a four year liberal arts university.

SEVEN SPRINGS

Nestled on the banks of the Neuse River, the tiny hamlet of Seven Springs holds the distinction of being the oldest settlement in Wayne County. During the Civil War, the town was a thriving community and was the site of a confederate shipyard. The natural springs that ultimately gave the town its name were developed following the Civil War.

Based on its strategic location, Wayne County has experienced a development boom. People here take pride in their communities and give back in countless ways. The result is an enviable quality of life for residents, fertile ground for businesses to grow and thrive, and a wide array of attractions, events and activities for visitors.

FURFKA

Located in the northeast portion, Eureka received its unusual moniker from a group of locals who were searching for a new name. As the story goes, one of them shouted out "Eureka!" which literally translated means "I've found it." The name stuck and was officially changed in 1901. With a population of just under 300, Eureka epitomizes old-fashioned community values.

PIKEVILLE


Established in 1891, Pikeville is one of the oldest towns in Wayne County and is now one of the fastest growing areas of the county. Easily accessible to Raleigh and the Research Triangle Park, Pikeville offers the advantage of small-town living with the convenience of a larger city.

FRFMONT

Fremont is a picturesque community located in the northern part of Wayne County with easy access to I-795 and I-95. With 1,500 residents, Fremont is locally known for its flowers found in the many wonderfully manicured lawns and public spaces. Fremont is also home to the Governor Charles B. Aycock Birthplace Historic Site.

VILLAGE OF WALNUT CREEK

Wayne County offers the very finest in country club living in the Village of Walnut Creek, located in the eastern part of the county. Ranked one of the wealthiest communities in North Carolina, Walnut Creek is comprised of elegant estates situated on gently rolling terrain in a natural, tree-covered expanse. Walnut Creek offers its members and guests the amenities of a first-rate country club.



HISTORY OF

Listen to the lessons of the past and learn why Wayne County is steeped with historical significance. Our rich history is laden with stories of Tuscarora Indians, steam boats, Revolutionary skirmishes, and Civil War battles. The world's longest railroad once ran through our county, as we are at the center of many a crossroad.

CIVIL WAR HISTORY

Goldsboro was an important railroad junction during the Civil War. Confederate troops were stationed here to guard the city and report for duty by rail. Hospitals were established and over 800 Confederate soldiers were buried in a mass grave at Willowdale Cemetery. Breastworks were built to protect the city. Remains are still visible along Claiborne Street. www.civilwartrails.org

THE BATTLE OF GOLDSBOROUGH BRIDGE: FOSTER'S RAID

In December 1862. Union General John Foster marched from New Bern with an army of 12,000 men. The intent was to interrupt the Confederate supply chain by destroying the railroad bridge which crossed the Neuse River, three miles south of Goldsborough. On December 17. Union troops attacked and pushed back a small force of 2,000 Confederates, then burned the bridge and destroyed miles of railroad tracks. That afternoon Confederate forces attacked the rear of Foster's army as it was leaving the field. The Confederates suffered over 150 casualties and Union losses were under 100. Re-enactments of the battle are held on the site every two years. www. goldsboroughbridge.com

THE UNION OCCUPATION OF GOLDSBOROUGH

In 1865, Goldsborough was Union General Sherman's destination on his march through the Carolinas. Three Union armies converged on Goldsborough and captured the city in March. Union hospitals were established, and the city was occupied for three weeks by over 100,000 Union soldiers.



SEYMOUR JOHNSON AIR FORCE BASE

First activated in 1942, the installation was named in honor of U.S. Navy Lt. Seymour A. Johnson, a Goldsboro native, who was killed in March 1941. By 1944, the primary mission of the base was to train P-47 Thunderbolt pilots. Following World War II, the base was inactivated. In 1954, Goldsboro Mayor Scott B. Berkeley Sr. and a group of business leaders successfully lobbied to have the base reopened. Seymour Johnson was reactivated in 1956. Two years later, the storied 4th Fighter Group then known as the 4th Fighter Day Wing arrived. Today it is home of the 4th Fighter Wing, which flies the F-15E Strike Eagle, and the 916th Air Refueling Wing, which flies the KC-135R Stratotanker. In 2001, former Department of Defense Secretary Donald H. Rumsfeld named SJAFB the winner of the 2001 Commander-In-Chief's Award for Installation Excellence, recognizing outstanding and innovative efforts. As one of five recipients of this award, SJAFB was selected for its exemplary support of the Department of Defense mission and received \$1.1 million in base improvements.

HSTORY OF WAYNE



fistoric Markers

Sherman's March: Sherman's army, on its march from Savannah, entered Goldsboro on March 21, 1865. NC 581 (West Ash Street) in Goldsboro.

North Carolina Railroad: Built by the state, 1851-56. Eastern terminus a few miles north. NC 581 (West Ash Street) in Goldsboro.

Curtis H. Brogden: Governor, 1874-77; home is two miles northwest on US 13 south of Goldsboro.

Foster's Raid: Union troops led by General J.G. Foster attacked Goldsboro, December 17, 1862. NC 581 (West Ash Street) in Goldsboro.

Wm. T. Dortch: Confederate Senator. US 70 Business (Ash Street) and William Street in Goldsboro.

Dobbs County Courthouse: Formed in 1758 and named for Governor Arthur Dobbs. 3 miles south. US 70 at SR 1719 (Best Station Road) east of Walnut Creek.

Seymour Johnson Air Force Base: Field used, 1942-46, for flight training by Army Air Forces; reopened in 1956. Berkeley Boulevard at Elm Street in Goldsboro.

Torhunta: Large Indian farming community. Destroyed in 1712. US 13 at SR 1572 (Saulston Road) 3 miles northeast of Goldsboro.

University of Mount Olive: Original Free Will Baptist. US 117 Bypass in Mount

Battle of Whitehall: On December 15-16, 1862, Union troops led by Gen. J.G. Foster damaged the Confederate Ram "Neuse." NC 55 at Main Street in Seven Springs.

North Carolina Press Association:

Organized May 14, 1873. J.A. Engelhard elected first president at a meeting held near this spot. Walnut Street in Goldsboro.

Odd Fellows Home: Orphanage and school opened in 1892. The original 20-acre tract is now a city park. US 70 Business (East Ash Street) at Herman Street in Goldsboro.


Cherry Hospital: Opened by the state in 1880 for black citizens with mental illness. US Hwy 581 at SR 201 (Stevens Mill Road) just west of Goldsboro.

General Baptist State Convention:

Statewide association of black Baptists organized October 18, 1867, at First African Baptist Church, then located .2 miles West. US Hwy 117 Business (George Street) at Pine Street in Goldsboro.

Gertrude Weil: 1879-1971; advocate for extending voting rights to women, 1920; home was here. 200 West Chestnut Street, Goldsboro.

Kenneth C. Royall: Last Secretary of War and First Secretary of the Army, 1947-49. Home was here. NC 581 (West Ash Street) in Goldsboro.

CHERRY HOSPITAL MUSEUM

Originally opened in 1880 by the state for African Americans with mental illnesses, Cherry Hospital was renamed in 1959 for Governor R. Grega Cherry. Patients worked its 3.500 acres of farmland until the 1970's. The museum depicts over a century of history with photographs, log books, and a variety of the hospital's authentic medical and farming equipment.

THE GOLDSBOROUGH BRIDGE BATTI FFIFI D

The battlefield is the site of the battle of Goldsborough Bridge, where on December 17, 1862. some 2,000 Confederate forces attempted to stop Union Gen. John Foster's 12,000 troops from destroying a vital railroad bridge. The bridge, located south of the city over the Neuse River, was a key position for both Union and Confederate forces. An informational kiosk provides visitors with a battlefield map and further information. Walking trails surround the cultivated field

which Confederate troops crossed during their bloody counterattack against the Union rear quard. These trails take visitors to nine additional historical markers where specific events of the battle are detailed. Two sets of well-preserved earthworks may be viewed, as well as the site of the Wilmington & Weldon Railroad Bridge, the objective of the Union army.

Mount Olive has been listed on the National Register of Historic Places since 1999.

DILLARD ALUMNI CENTER/H.V. **BROWN HALL**

In 1869, the Quakers offered to provide a free school for African American Children. if the parents could furnish a building. The school opened in 1882 under the name Goldsboro Grade School. Reverend Clarence Dillard came to Goldsboro in 1884 to serve as pastor of the Presbyterian (Shiloh) Church. In 1894, Reverend Dillard became principal of the school. The building that Reverend Dillard saw erected was named Dillard High School. In 1956, the school celebrated 30 years of accreditation and two vears later, a national alumni association organization was chartered. The group, "Dillard/ Goldsboro Alumni and Friends, Inc.," attracts thousands of visitors each Memorial Day weekend and has a full-service community facility.

The Bryan Multi-Sports Complex, a 63-acre facility adiacent to Sevmour Johnson AFB. is a first-of-its-kind partnership between a military base and its home community. UNITED WAY FILLS IN GAPS FOR people in need

Meals on Wheels helps adults remain home

People in Wayne County who need help — whether it's financial, educational, health and wellness or disaster assistance — can get that help through United Way of Wayne County.

The organization has been here since 1925. It actually began in 1887 when the Red Feather Agency was formed in Denver. During World War I, it became the War Chest. After the war, it changed its name to Community Chest in 1917.

The Community Chest in Goldsboro became known as the United Fund of Goldsboro in 1954 and changed its name once again to Wayne United Way in 1974.

The Taste of Wayne, the organization's major fundraiser, began in 1991 and continues today.

The United Way relief fund was established in 1996 for local emergency disaster relief.

United Way conducts an annual campaign to help various local agencies here.

One of those is WAGES Nutrition Program for the Elderly, which encompasses Meals on Wheels and congregate feeding.

MEALS ON WHEELS



The nutrition program for the elderly feeds close to 500 people, including those at the two congregate sites. There are 28 Meals on Wheels routes throughout the county, with about 350 participants. Between 40 and 50 volunteers deliver the meals every day.





Brownie Doss, director of older adult services at WAGES, said the congregate part of the program began in the 1970s and Meals on Wheels was started in the early 1980s. The congregate part serves people ages 60 and older at a set site, one at the Peggy Seegars Senior Center and another at the Mount Olive Senior Center.

"Meals on Wheels is mainly for seniors," Doss said. "But we've had people who are younger than 60 who maybe had a stroke and are paralyzed on one side who met all the qualifications except the age. United Way stepped up and helps us with people who are younger than 60, about 30 throughout the county currently."

Meals on Wheels is for homebound seniors, who wouldn't otherwise be able to stay at home if not for the program.

Every day, the nutrition program for the elderly feeds close to 500 people, including those at the two congregate sites. There are 28 Meals on Wheels routes throughout the county, with about 350 participants. It takes between 40 and 50 volunteers to deliver the meals every day, Doss said.

"Our volunteers get to know the folks and it's good for us because the volunteers are our eyes out there," she said. "If they see something different about that person they're delivering a meal to, they report it to us.


"Sometimes our folks won't want their family to know something's wrong and they'll tell our volunteers before they tell their family."

Doss said all of the meals are prepared by staff at the WAGES commercial kitchen. Volunteers deliver the meals Monday through Friday.

"We are very fortunate here in Wayne County to have volunteers, but we always need more," she said. "We really need some in the Dudley area.

If not for Meals on Wheels, a lot of these people would not be able to stay in their homes. A lot of them might be institutionalized. Not only is it much less for them to stay at home, but it's also less expensive for taxpayers. People don't realize how much Medicare dollars it takes to keep people in nursing homes — where they don't want to be anyway.







I will continue volunteering with Meals on Wheels as long as I'm able.

One of those volunteers delivering meals to the homebound is 72-year-old Martha Bryan, who has been doing it since 2003 when she retired. She also got her brother to start delivering meals when he retired.

She said she knew Meals on Wheels helped seniors stay in their homes and wanted to be a part of that.

"I've had the same route the whole time," Bryan said. "Of my 14, right now probably eight or nine are in their 90s. Were they not able to get these meals, they would probably not be able to stay at home.

"Plus, it's a way for them to see somebody. I enjoy people so I enjoy seeing them each time. They get used to you and if you're not there, they miss you. That's why I've just kept doing it."

Bryan said Meals on Wheels participants are appreciative of the hot meals she brings them. And they enjoy her company, too.

"I had one lady, Miss Betty Burden, who died just recently at 98," she said. "I had been working with her for years. When my grandchildren were little and used to come to visit, they would go with me and all the clients would love it, including Miss Betty.

"When I had knee surgery last year and was out three months, one day my brother was at her house and she wanted to talk to me, so he called me from her house to let her talk to me. Probably a month later, my brother was there and Miss Betty wanted to talk to me again."

Bryan also recalls the time about three years ago when one elderly woman was all dressed up when she delivered her meal.

"She said she was supposed to go to a funeral, but her ride called and couldn't take her," Bryan said. "I told

her I'd take her when I got done delivering meals. She still to this day thanks me for taking her to the funeral. Things like that make me feel good."

Not only is Bryan taking a hot meal to a senior, but she's also checking in on them at the same time. If anything's wrong at a participant's home or someone doesn't answer the door, she reports it back to WAGES for a follow up on that person.

And she's thankful she's had only one incident in her years of delivering meals.

"I went to a man's home to deliver a meal and he didn't answer," Bryan said. "The door was open so I went in and called and called his name. He had slid off his bed and was on the floor, but he wasn't hurt. He was usually in a wheelchair or a chair. Luckily, I had someone with me that day. We were able to get him up."

Bryan said she will continue volunteering with Meals on Wheels as long as she's able.

Wayne County offers a large variety of things to do and services to people of all ages, including veterans and their families needing assistance and adults looking for work a home. schools and recreation.

The county has more than 30 public schools serving more than 18,000 students, with 74 percent of the Wayne County Public School graduates planning to pursue higher education. The public school system has more than 180 partners in education, consisting of area businesses and organizations, according to Public School Review.

VETERANS SERVICES

In Goldsboro, Wayne County offers a Veterans Services Office located at 2001 E. Ash St. that helps veterans and their families access needed benefits.

Amy Smith, director of the Veteran Services Office, said the office serves any of the 12,000 veterans in Wayne County and veterans from surrounding counties.

"Our main goal is to help vets file claims," Smith said. "We help them get compensation for their families that are entitled to help them complete pending claims."

The majority of clients at the Veteran Services Office are Vietnam veterans and there are also veterans from different wars up to the Gulf War, Smith said.

Veterans also get help with education and training benefits they are eligible for and burial and survivor benefits, Smith said.

"We help them navigate through the Veterans Administration system to get those benefits," she said.

Counselors are also available for group sessions, Smith said. For more information, veterans may go to waynegov.com/427/ veterans-services.

SENIOR CENTER

The Wayne County' Peggy M. Seegars Senior Center and Services on Aging, at 2001 E. Ash St., has activities and services for seniors.

Paula Edwards, director of Wayne County Services on Aging, said many people in Wayne County are not aware of what the Senior Center and Services on Aging offers.

"It's not like a nursing home, Edwards said, It is very active." The people who come here do not act like old people. We're trying to change that perception. It's a great place to come to. If someone does need help, this is the place where they can come and see what might be available to them."

The Senior Center has nearly 1,000 members and people join almost weekly, Edwards said.

The Senior Center provides everything from exercise classes to health talks and special events. There are fitness rooms, a computer room and pool tables. There is also a Songbird choir and line dancing.

The Services on Aging has a program called Group Respite, which is offered at the Senior Center, and designed to give

caregivers a break from watching over someone with Alzheimer's Disease or dementia. Edwards said.

There is an In-Home Aide Program that provides services to homebound elderly residents that helps them avoid institutionalization by receiving help with household tasks, like vacuuming, changing bed linens and other chores, that arthritis or other conditions prevent them from doing.

The center uses the Gateway Transit System to provide medical and general transportation to seniors throughout Wayne County. The service helps residents who otherwise would not be able to see a doctor, travel for dialysis treatments, go grocery shopping or visit the Senior Center. Edwards said.

"We're just a hub for seniors 60 and older for Wayne County," she said. "We want the seniors to live well and we hope we contribute to that and help them get out of the home. I've seen people come in who were down and depressed and lonely."

But the Senior Center and being with people seems to make them happier, Edwards said.

"It's very important they get out of their homes and connect with people and have support groups as well," she said.

FARMERS MARKET, LIBRARIES. **GOVERNMENT SERVICES**

Other services that can be found in the county include the Farm Credit Farmers Market behind the new, state-of-the-art Maxwell Center in Goldsboro. The market offers fresh local produce in April

from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Thursdays and Fridays and 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Saturdays.

The Wayne Executive Jetport, in the vicinity of Pikeville, provides an opportunity for industrial executives to bring more industry to the county.

The Wayne County Health Department, at 301 N. Herman St., offers a variety of programs and services from dental, maternity, family planning and testing and screening for sexually transmitted diseases, HIV and tuberculosis.

The Wavne County Public Library. at 1001 E. Ash St., has branches in Pikeville. Fremont and Mount Olive and offers programs for youth and adults.

The Wayne County Department of Social Services, at 301 N. Herman St., has a mission to improve the quality of life for all county residents.

When people can't maintain a home of their own because of a temporary or chronic physical condition or mental disability and more care is needed than can be provided by family, Wayne County Social Services offers in-home aid or community services.

DSS also provides adult protection services to assure that disabled adults are protected from abuse, neglect and exploitation; eye care that consists of eye examinations, eye glasses, eye treatment, eye surgery, hospitalization for eye disorders, ocular prostheses and eye medications; nursing home placement; and services for the blind.

Communities Supporting Schools of Wayne County has one goal — keep kids in school. Everything the nonprofit organization does for the students living in Wayne County follows this line of thinking, said Selena Bennett, executive director of the organization since 2011.

Whether it is mentoring young students to promote confidence and success or helping students stay out of the juvenile justice system through diversion programs and Teen Court, Community Supporting Schools of Wayne County does it all

"We wear a lot of different hats depending on what that school principal wants us to do," said Bennett. "Everything connects in the middle because the goal is to keep kids in school. We're trying to keep them there so that they will graduate and go on to either a college, learn a trade, join the military or whatever it is.

"We're trying to help them be successful on their chosen path, whatever that may be."

Communities Supporting Schools of Wayne County began in 1992 with a task force that formed to organize a Communities in Schools (CIS) agency in Wayne County. At that time, the group worked to form the core of the organization before turning it over to a board of directors in 1993 who then hired the first executive director in 1994.

For 23 years, Communities in Schools of Wayne County, as it was called at the time, worked diligently to serve students living in Wayne County through various programs and efforts. The organization was affiliated

with the national organization of CIS but ultimately made a huge decision in 2017 to break away from the national organization, since its values were no longer in line with what the Wayne County group needed at the time.

While the name of CIS of Wavne changed to Communities Supporting Schools of Wayne County, the overall mission and goals of the organization stayed the same — to serve students, to keep students in school and to keep students on a path toward success.

Today, the organization partners with seven Wayne County public schools: Goldsboro, Southern Wayne and Spring Creek high schools; Grantham, Broaden and Mount Olive middle schools: and Carver Heights Elementary School.

Success coaches, who work directly with the school leadership team to target at-risk students in an attempt to help them reach their potential, are placed in those seven schools, Bennett said. The coach's responsibilities in each school vary depending on student needs, so where Goldsboro High might need a mentor to help students prepare for life after high school and applying for colleges, other schools may need a reading mentor or a special case manager.

"Our goal is to target those kids who need additional support in the schools," Bennett said.

The nonprofit also operates three additional programs under the Restorative Justice branch of the organization: Teen Court. Mediation and Community Services.

The North Carolina Department of Public Safety partners with Juvenile Crime **Prevention Councils** across the state in an effort to reduce and

offenses through community service, jury duty and other educational opportunities. Juveniles are referred to the program by juvenile court counselors, school resource officers and district court judges.

Juveniles may be referred to the Community Service program as "restitution" for their offenses. This allows students to "pay back" their community for breaking the law through volunteer work. Students may be placed at nonprofit organizations, such as the Goldsboro Family YMCA, the Boys and Girls Clubs of Wayne County, the

prevent juvenile crime. CSS of Wayne operates the three programs under state guidelines.

"We know that, when they are suspended, they are more likely to continue down a path," Bennett said. "Suspension for some kids means going home to no supervision, and for some kids, you're giving them exactly what they want. That's not an answer to anything.

"Once kids get mixed up in the juvenile court system, the chances of them not graduating and then you get into the pipeline-to-prison discussion, once they get into that, it's harder to get them out."

Teen court is a diversion program for juvenile offenders between ages 12 and 18 who are still enrolled in school. The students "make restitution" for their misdemeanor

Salvation Army Family Store and Habitat for Humanity.

The Mediation Conflict Resolution Program helps students discuss difficult issues and guide them through a structured setting, Bennett said. It is used to help students work through conflict and develop resolution skills before they fall into fighting or bullying. Students are referred to the program through teachers, school administration or school resource officers.

The Mediation Conflict Resolution Program began in Dillard Middle School and has now expanded to Goldsboro High School, Bennett said.

Communities Supporting Schools of Wayne County partners with many organizations to provide a number of services for Wayne County students. This includes holding fundraisers, school supply drives and more

Seymour Johnson has a proud heritage dating back to 1942.

It was established five months after the United States entered World War II. The War Department approved the establishment of a technical school 2 miles southeast of Goldsboro.

The base was activated June 12, 1942. It was named in honor of United States Navy Lt. Seymour A. Johnson, a Goldsboro native and test pilot, who was killed in an airplane crash in Maryland in 1941.

In June 1943, the base began preparing officers and enlisted personnel for duty overseas. That unit was known as the Provisional Overseas Replacement Training Center.

Then in 1943, another mission was added: to provide basic military training for cadets preparing to become technical officers in the Army Air Corps. The 75th Training Wing was established for this purpose.

The 326th Fighter Group arrived in October 1943, and in January 1944 it began training replacement pilots for P-47 Thunderbolt aircraft. That became the primary mission of Seymour Johnson Field that April.

At the end of World War II in Europe, the base became a central assembly station for processing and training troops being reassigned in the continental United States and the Pacific theater of operations. But that was discontinued in September 1945 and the base became an Army Air Forces Separation Center.

The base was deactivated in May 1946.

The United States Army Corps of Engineers demolished old buildings and began building new ones in late 1952.

Goldsboro community leaders, led by Mayor Scott B. Berkeley Sr., began a campaign to have the installation reopened.

It worked, and April 1, 1956, Seymour Johnson Air Force Base was reactivated as a Tactical Air Command base. Three months later, the 83rd Fighter-Day Wing was assigned to the base as its primary unit. It was replaced by the 4th Fighter Wing Dec. 8, 1957.

The base has been home to active duty. Air National Guard and Air Reserve B-52 bombers, KC-10 and KC-135 tankers and F-4D/E, F-16, F-102, F-106 and F-15E aircraft.



Force Base go hand-in-hand, supporting each other and celebrating each other's milestones. The base has a definite impact on Wayne County's economy, too.

Seymour Johnson was annexed by the City of Goldsboro Feb. 7, 1977.

Base personnel volunteer in various capacities at various organizations throughout the county.

The strong partnership between the base and surrounding communities is evidenced by the city's motto "Be More, Do More, Seymour."

4th Fighter Wing

The 4th Fighter Wing is one of only two Air Force units that can trace its history to another country.

Before the United States got into World War II, American volunteers were already serving as combat veterans in the Royal Air Force Eagle Squadrons, the 71st, the 121st and the 133rd.

The 4th Fighter Group was the first to use belly tanks, the first to penetrate Germany, the first to accompany bombers to Berlin, the first to fly the England-to-Russia

shuttle and the first to down jet fighters.

It was inactivated at Camp Kilmer, N.J., in 1945.

In March 1949, it transitioned to F-86 Sabre jets, just in time for the Korean War. In December 1950, it was designated the 4th Fighter-Interceptor Group.

It became the 4th Fighter Wing Dec. 1, 1995.

916th Air Refueling Wing

The 916th Air Refueling Wing also has a rich history in Goldsboro that started more than 70 years ago. Its history dates back to World War II. It officially became mission ready in April 1997 with the task of refueling domestic and global exercise and operational flights.


