

# **SHARED SPACE**

Co-working offices starting to bounce back amid pandemic

At first glance, co-working offices would seem to be headed for a lot of trouble in a time when we're all supposed to be staying at least 6 feet apart from one another.

Co-working offices are designed to provide adaptable spaces at reasonable rates — a goal often met by renting out desks in rooms with open-floor plans to businesses and professionals. But such arrangements can lead to the opposite of social distancing, especially when people enjoying the random encounters which occur when they work near one another in shared space.

But, after this spring's sudden drop in business, which included one co-working space shutting down permanently, some Milwaukee-area spaces are now seeing increased activity — including among people who are tired of working at home because of the coronavirus pandemic.

"I think they want to get to a more professional environment," said Lisa Caesar, who operates No Studios.

No Studios, an office and events venue that has shared working space, is at

# Subcontractor killed on site of \$500M paper mill

A man died Friday morning after being struck by a telehandler on the site of a \$500 million Green Bay Packaging paper mill under construction in the city.

Authorities say a 52-year-old man was killed when he was struck by a Skytrak lift vehicle and was dead by the time authorities arrived on the jobsite at about 9 a.m. Friday.

Lt. Jeff Engelbrecht, of the Green Bay Police Department, said the man killed worked for a subcontractor on the project but couldn't identify the company on Friday morning. Miron Construction is overseeing the construction of the new mill and has enlisted some 600 subcontractors on the project. Miron didn't return a message seeking comment by press

time Friday.

"We are deeply saddened to share that an individual, who was employed by one of our subcontractors and was involved in a serious incident this morning at one of our Green Bay project sites, has succumbed to his injuries," Miron said in an official statement. "We extend

# **Court: Michigan Great Lakes tunnel deal constitutional**

TRAVERSE CITY, Mich. (AP) — The Michigan Court of Appeals ruled Thursday that legislators did not violate the state constitution by allowing the construction of an oil pipeline tunnel beneath a channel linking two of the Great Lakes, clearing the way for the project to proceed unless another court intervenes.

A three-judge panel affirmed a ruling last November by the Michigan Court of Claims, which upheld a law authorizing a deal between former Republican Gov. Rick Snyder and Canadian pipeline company Enbridge.

The two parties had negotiated a plan to drill the tunnel through bedrock beneath the Straits of Mackinac, which connects Lakes Michigan and Huron and divides Michigan's upper and lower peninsulas.

The tunnel is meant to house a pipeline that would replace a four-milelong underwater segment of Enbridge's Line 5, which carries crude oil and natural gas liquids used in propane between the city of Superior and Sarnia, Ontario.

Lawmakers approved the agreement during a lame-duck session in December 2018 over objections that the proposal was drafted sloppily and rushed to enactment before Gov. Gretchen Whitmer, who criticized the deal, took over for Snyder the following month.

"The handout to Enbridge allowed the company to avoid the normal vetting process of a project of this magnitude — cutting out public comment and input," said Beth Wallace, conservation partnerships manager for the National Wildlife Federation's Great Lakes office.

Snyder and Republican legislators said the deal was struck after years of public discussion.

Attorney General Dana Nessel, also a Democrat, issued an opinion in March 2019 finding that the authorization of the bill was unconstitutional because its provisions far exceeded what its title specified.

Enbridge requested a ruling from the Court of Claims, where Judge Michael Kelly found that lawmakers had adequately followed the constitutional requirement to express a bill's "general purpose or object" in its title.

Appeals judges Thomas Cameron, Mark Boonstra and Anica Letica — all appointed by Snyder — agreed.

"We conclude that the title ... does not address objects so diverse that they have no necessary connection," they said in a written opinion Thursday.

The ruling was a victory for Enbridge, which says it plans to finish the tunnel by 2024.

"We look forward to working with the state to make a safe pipeline even safer," spokesman Ryan Duffy said. "We are investing \$500 million in the tunnel's construction - thereby further protecting the waters of the Great Lakes and everyone who uses them."

Whitmer's office is reviewing the de-

Nessel will ask the Michigan Supreme Court to take the case.

"While we are disappointed by the Court of Appeals' decision, we stand by our position that (the law) is unconstitutional," she said.

The constitution's provision about titles is intended to prevent deception about what bills would do.

The disputed measure's title was lengthy, authorizing state boards to acquire and operate the planned tunnel and perform numerous other duties. Even so, Nessel argued that the bill went well beyond what the title indicated.

But the appeals judges found that "neither the legislators nor the public were deprived of fair notice" of the contents.

Nessel is pursuing a separate lawsuit that seeks to shut down Line 5 — long a goal of environmentalists who say a rupture could devastate waters and shorelines in a sensitive area home to endangered species and prized by tour-

The 67-year-old underwater segment consists of two pipes that carry a combined 23 million gallons daily. Enbridge says the lines are inspected regularly and are in good condition. But protective outer coating has worn away in some spots and erosion has required the installation of steel braces. A barge and tugboat anchor struck the pipes in 2018.

"This daily threat must end regardless if any oil tunnel is ever constructed," said Sean McBrearty, campaign coordinator for the group Oil & Water Don't Mix.

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# Staying clean

# Steps to take to help employees avoid substance abuse

I know a safety professional at a construction company who found a small, plastic bag with white powder on a work site. What's the right thing to do with something like that? More importantly, what can managers do to help employees avoid substance abuse that threatens their safety and health – both at work and at home?

We know that substance abuse is a serious concern in the construction industry, which has some of the highest rates of substance abuse among all industries. This is especially troubling for our industry, in which workers are routinely operating machinery, using tools and spending time in work environments with high risk for accidents. Research indicates that substance abuse is associated with lost productivity, higher absenteeism, workplace accidents, staff turnover, increased costs and lower morale. Not only does this expose your employees to harm, but it can raise your costs as a business, cause delays in completing projects and affect your risk ratings. There are no simple answers, but there are four things that can help:

#### Instruction

Front-line superintendents and crew leaders need to be trained on what to look for with substance abuse. Employers should provide instruction on opioids – including common brands, risk factors for opioid misuse, and reasons for opioid prescriptions. This should also discuss non-opioid pain-relief alternatives, signs of opioid disorder, ways to safely dispose of opioids, and ways to talk to family and friends about opioid use. Remember that follow-up training is equally important in that it can reduce the chance that someone takes an opioid of opioid use disorder.


#### **Policies**

Workplace policies help set expectations and boundaries for employees. Have clear, compassionate, drug-free workplace policies in place; when employees understand and follow policies designed to prevent unnecessary opioid use, their risk for misusing opioids or developing an opioid-use disorder decreases. Managers and supervisors are often the first to notice impairment or other signs of drug use. Train them on policies and procedures, and on recognizing impairment. Identifying and dealing with these situations early can prevent safety hazards and prevent opioid misuse or OUD from becoming worse.

Medical-leave policies should be flexible enough for employees to attend medical appointments and heal fully before returning to work after an injury. Overly restrictive policies can lead to employees taking prescribed opioids for longer than necessary or illegally obtaining opioids so they can return to work early – even if they are not ready. This may also lead to skipping medical appointments necessary for recovery from injury or their recovery from an OUD.

#### Workplace culture

One of the strongest prevention mechanisms an employer can provide is a supportive workplace =. This can lessen the effects of factors that put people more at risk for developing an opioid-use disorder. If employees feel supported and encouraged to seek help when needed, an early diagnosis can



Hold stress to a minimum in the workplace; encourage self-care, and support from managers and supervisors when employees complain of stress. Promote ergonomic and overexertion initiatives and follow best practices to reduce injury risk in the workplace. Support recovery in the workplace and serve no alcohol at work-sponsored events.

#### Benefits and health care plans

Benefits and health care plans can provide preventative services as well as treatment. All services provided should be confidential and easy to use. Ensure health care plans cover mental and behavioral health services, and encourage annual screenings for substance-use disorders. Ensure the coverage of alternative pain management treatments including non-opioid drugs, acupuncture, chiropractic, physical and occupational therapy. Add a program that helps manage the prescribing of opioids and prescription opioid use many pharmacy benefit management programs now offer opioid-specific services.

provide help to employees and their loved ones who are working through an opioid use disorder. Easy access to support and medical care can prevent early stages of a substance-use disorder from becoming more serious.

Now, about that bag. What this safety professional did, after talking it over with others at the company, was to flush the contents of the bag down the toilet. This is not recommended. My acquaintancs in law enforcement, on hearing about what the contents of the bag looked like, tell me it very likely contained fentanyl. Even a tiny amount of this could induce a fatal reaction. Much better would be to call law enforcement and let them take care of it. Needless to say, the person who found the bag and touched it with bare hands was quite concerned, and for good reason.

But finding the bag served as an early warning that employees were at risk and in need.

Fentanyl is a synthetic opioid considered to be up to 50 times more potent than heroin, and was involved in 80% of the of the 140 overdose deaths among construction, maintenance and natural resources workers in Rhode Island. It also was linked to 75% of the overall drug overdose deaths. The construction industry needs to be more vigilant about drugs on our sites and the use of them by our workers. Effective policies, supportive workplaces, and appropriate employee benefits and health care plans are four ways employers can help.

# So far, only one Milwaukee co-working space has closed

1037 W. McKinley Ave. It opened in 2019 at The Brewery, a mixed-use development which replaced Pabst Brewing Co.'s former downtown complex.

No Studios, which draws much of its income from events, shut down in mid-March. It plans to reopen July 1.

Caesar and others who operate coworking spaces say they're getting more inquiries and renters as businesses reopen and the economy slowly recovers.

Novel Coworking, of Chicago, opened its downtown Milwaukee operation, at 790 N Milwaukee St., in January.

The six-story building is around half leased — which is what Novel projected it would be at this point in its first year, said Allison Voigts, director of marketing.

Serendipity Labs Inc., out of Rye., New York, opened a large co-working center in February at 11220 W. Burleigh St., at Wauwatosa's Mayfair Collection mixed-use development.

Serendipity saw the demand for its offerings fall about 80% during March and April, said Paula Gomprecht, vice president of marketing.

By May, she said, the company was back to around 65% of its activity level before the COVID-19 pandemic hit

Novel and Serendipity have used their office designs, as well as additional safety measures, to combat the pandemic's spread.

The accommodations include common areas with properly-spaced seating arrangements; high-grade ventilation systems; hands-free entries, and an increase in cleaning. Both companies also provide private offices along with the shared working spaces.

In addition, Serendipity is requiring face masks to be worn in shared spaces, and is conducting a brief health screening of every person who enters a com-

pany office.

Those are sensible measures, said Sue Gresham, who uses Serendipity's Wauwatosa center for Innovative Client Solutions LLC, her business consulting firm.

"It's what we have to do," said Gresham, who worked out of her Pewaukee home for 10 years before shifting to the co-working site.

Managers at Novel and Serendipity, which are both privately held and do not publicly report their financial results, say co-working remains an attractive option for office users.

Demand is partly driven by large employers that want more leeway in providing work spaces, said Kayley DiCicco, Novel's national accounts manager.

That involves spreading employees out among conventional offices, home offices and co-working sites, DiCicco said.

Companies want to separate employees "to limit risk of exposure and also need space for overflow, since employees may not fit in their current offices once social distancing measures are applied to their workspace," said Gomprecht of Serendipity.

To be sure, the pandemic's economic toll has hit one high-profile Milwau-

kee co-working site: Hudson Business Lounge.

Hudson opened in 2012 at 310 E. Buffalo St., in the Historic Third Ward, and was one of Milwaukee's first coworking spaces. The pandemic forced its closing in March, said Dan Walsh, a founder.

Hudson's location in a high-rent area did not position the company well in the pandemic, Walsh said.

Also, Hudson had a much more common space than most co-working spaces, which tend to have more private offices, he said.

"It's very hard to be socially distant when your entire business model is based on meetings, gatherings and shared resources," Walsh said.

But co-working remains attracting, said Walsh, who's also an commercial office space broker at Transwestern.

The financial planner Jared Andreoli started his firm, Simplicity Financial LLC, about 18 months ago. He worked out of his Bay View home, and used Hudson Business Lounge for client meetings.

Andreoli recently began renting space at Ward4, a co-working center at 313 N. Plankinton Ave., just south of downtown.

He's used it for more than just client meetings — in part to provide separation between his living space and his work space.

"It's nice to see other people working," Andreoli said.

He added, "It's very easy to find things to distract you when you're at home."

Ward4, like other co-working sites, is seeing a gradual rebound in business after a big drop in March and April, said Steve Mech, president of CSA Commercial Inc. That firm, owned by former County Executive Chris Abele, opened the center in 2015.

"It was a pretty rough time initially as people wondered what the future looks like," Mech said. "We're holding our own."

Ward4 has kept its tenants apart, taking advantage of its conference room to help with social distancing, Mech said. And, it is "cleaning like crazy," he said.

Meanwhile, Sieria Payne is anxiously waiting for a business rebound to help her new center, The Business Coworking Lounge.

Payne started the east-side center, at 902 E. Hamilton St., in February, with a grand opening on March 8.

The pandemic began causing widespread business shutdowns throughout Wisconsin just one week later.

"It crushed us like a rock," said Payne, whose facility is aimed at women entrepreneurs.

Her co-working space reopened with reduced capacity on May 26, just after Memorial Day. Business so far has been slow.

Payne has supported it through her savings, and with revenue from a women's clothing boutique she operates. But The Business Coworking Lounge needs more renters.

"It still hasn't returned to normal,"


