ELECTRICAL SAFETY RULES:

All docks need continual inspections by their owners. Water movement can cause wear on your dock's electrical equipment. Monthly ground fault circuit interrupter (GFCI) testing of electrical equipment and bonding wires is recommended.

During the winter, wires and electrical outlets can deteriorate due to freezing and thawing. Electrical equipment that worked well the prior season will need to be inspected before using the dock again.

Have both the dock and the power supply to the dock regularly inspected by a qualified electrician. Electrical problems in or near the house and lines feeding the dock can cause life-threatening problems, even with docks that meet code and have been inspected.

Never swim around a dock where breakers or GFCIs are tripping. HEED THE WARNING SIGNS! If in doubt, swim away from the dock and get out! If a breaker or GFCI trips, something is wrong and the dock should be considered unsafe until a qualified electrician inspects and fixes the problem.

Never attempt to energize or re-energize, engage a breaker, or reset a GFCI while someone is swimming near the dock. Get the dock inspected and fixed before using or swimming nearby.


Do not touch any part of the dock or adjacent docks if a tingle or shock is felt. Swim or get away from the dock, cables and attachments. Exit the water away from the source of the shock. If possible, swim to the shoreline and exit there.


I show my beloved friend, Jamie, to her guest bedroom and hall bath. She marvels at its coziness. I assure her I'm just in the next room if she should need anything.



e all come to Lake of the Ozarks for the same reason: to enjoy being on the water. Whether it is coving out, bar hopping, or just a long boat ride, for us boat lovers you almost can't beat a good day on the Lake.

But let's face it, the Lake can be a busy place, and sometimes we crave something a little more laid back. Want to feel a little closer to nature? Listen to the sounds of running water, hear the birds chirping? Ditch the engine and grab a paddle!

Now, the Lake of the Ozarks is a powerboating haven, so not every place is suitable for a paddling excursion. Coves and shorelines

can often be a great place to enjoy kayaking or canoeing; especially during the busy summer boating season, it's prudent not to contend with weekend water traffic. However, Ha Ha Tonka cove is a favorite paddling spot yearround, and as the summer vacation boating quickly dies down, the Lake grows suddenly calm: perfect for paddlers. But there are some spots in the Lake area where canoes, kayaks and paddleboards are actually the preferred mode of transportation. Here are a couple of my favorites.

1. The Big Niangua River Trail

The first is what the Osage Indians called the Big Niangua River, which

means Big Winding Stream of Many Springs. This is the river that forms the Big Niangua Arm of Lake of the Ozarks. The Big Niangua offers great paddling south of here near Bennett Springs, and there are plenty of outfitters to take care of you. But there's a way to enjoy a Big Niangua float closer to home—if "home" is the Lake. As a way to create more awareness of this beautiful river, the Lake Ozark Master Naturalists, with help from Lake Ozark Watershed Alliance, Ameren Missouri, Missouri Department of Conservation, and Missouri State Parks, have created the Big Niangua River Trail. This 13.3 mile float starts at Whistle Bridge and ends at Ha Ha Tonka State Park. ▶ turn ▶

The trail is a self-guided tour of historic features and landmarks. Each stop is marked by a sign with a letter, A through T. A few of my favorite spots...

- Letters Q Flat Rock Hole and R — Nettie Hole — are both fishing holes that locals may wish had not been published!
- Two of the stops L Tie Bank
 — and G Roofener Chute are
 historic from the late 1800s and
 early 1900s as settlers cut timber for
 railroad ties.
- Stop J is Rodger Ford, where early settlers looked for places to cross, or ford, the river.
- The most historic stop on the trail is 0 — Tunnel Dam Power House. Constructed in 1929 by Sho-Me Power Electric Cooperative, Tunnel Dam is an 800 foot long tunnel constructed through the ridge by manual labor. It still produces electricity today.
- The most unpopular sign along the way has to be H — Boundary of the Big Niangua and the Lake of the Ozarks. This is where the river current stops and the serious paddling begins. The paddle ends at Ha Ha Tonka State Park, which will be to your right and easy to find.

To start the paddle, take 54 west out of Camdenton. Turn left on State Hwy. U to the town of Edith. Make a right on Whistle Road and follow it down to the river. Turn left over Whistle Bridge.

There are currently no outfitters on this section of the river, so you must arrange your own shuttle. You can unload your equipment on the gravel bar just across the bridge. Then take Tunnel Dam Road to State Hwy. D. Turn left and take this to Tonka Spring Road. You can park your vehicle there and shuttle back to Whistle Bridge to start your paddle.

For the complete map and guide to the Big Niangua River Trail, visit www. lakeozarkmasternaturalist.com. Printed copies are available at Ha Ha Tonka park office and at Wilmore Lodge.

2. The Little Niangua

The second paddle is an easy 30-minute drive from the square in Camdenton. A short trip down 54 to Macks Creek, turn right on State Hwy. N to Bannister Hollow Road, will take you to Cedar Camp on the Little Niangua. This river eventually becomes part of Lake of the Ozarks, too, merging with the Big Niangua at about the 6 Mile Marker of that arm of the Lake.

Cedar Camp has been operating since 1998 on the Little Niangua River. They offer a large variety of float trips ranging from a short,

scenic 2-mile float all the way up to a 13-mile adventure. This river is a nice float for families with young children. It has a relatively mild current, so you don't have to worry about swift current and undertows.

The Little Niangua is considered one of the best fishing rivers in the state. It is especially known for smallmouth bass fishing. The folks at Cedar Camp say you can catch smallmouth bass on minnows and jigs. They also have been known to bite on hot dogs, or just about anything. A tall tale around there is of a lady who catches smallmouth with gummy bears.

The 2-mile paddle starts at Green's Ford and ends at Cedar Camp, which is located at Howard's Ford. A great 4-mile family float is from Howard's Ford to Bannister Ford. This is a very scenic float with some great gravel bars and swimming holes. The highlight of this paddle is Burnt Mill Spring and Cave. It is called Burnt Spring because of the mill that was constructed there and burned during the Civil War.

Cedar Camp offers both canoes and kayaks for rent. They also will shuttle you for a small fee if you have your own equipment. Both camping and cabin rentals are available.



ake Area realtor Matt Schrimpf and his wife Kristi knew they wanted a house with a view of Six-Mile Cove. A quiet refuge where they could watch their three kids tube and wake surf.

It took a while, as anyone who knows anything about real estate at the Lake would expect, but the Schrimpfs eventually found their spot in the Village of Four Seasons.

One of Schrimpf's favorite features of the home are the iconic exposed wooden beams that he wouldn't exactly call "Coloradoish," but that really did it for him

mission style," he said. "Everything we do is a little bit outside of the normal."

After Ancell and the Schrimpfs clicked, they proceeded with the project, tapping Lake Area architect, Donald Campbell, to design the home.

"They wanted big views and big windows and they had a lot of things they knew they wanted," Ancell said.

"He always knew he wanted these big exposed pillars and beams," Ancell said of Schrimpf. "He told me what he had in his head and I took what he told me and turned it into what he has there."

The project didn't come without challenges of course.

Ancell built the house from the bottom up, and the biggest obstacle was the driveway.

"I'm a big homebuilder," Ancell said. "I've done about 70 houses, but there's always one thing that sticks out to be more of a problem."

"This one was the driveway."

Ancell said that during construction, building the driveway was pretty intense after they hit solid rock.

"I mean we hammered and hammered

on this rock. I'd sit on a machine myself for days on end trying to get this driveway lowered. That was probably our biggest obstacle on this one."

"It was quite the process," he said. With challenges overcome, Ancell said that the two features of the home that he and the Schrimpfs really resonated with were the kitchen and

screen room, in addition to a vaulted ceiling and chandeliers.





Don't Play Politics with Your Portfolio

You're probably aware this is an election year. During the next several months, the candidates will discuss issues that should greatly interest you as a citizen. But as an investor, how concerned should you be with the results of the presidential and congressional elections?

Maybe not as much as you might think. At different times, the financial markets have performed well and poorly under different administrations and when different parties have controlled Congress. And after all the votes are counted, outcomes in the investment markets can be unpredictable. Consequently, you'll be helping yourself greatly by not making big moves in your portfolio in anticipation of new legislation or political moves down the line.

Of course, that's not to say that nothing emerging from Washington could ever have an impact on your investment decisions. For example, if a future president and Congress decide to change the capital gains tax rate, it could affect some of your choices, such as which stocks and stock-based mutual funds you should buy, and how long you should hold them.

Overall, though, your investment results will ultimately depend on actions you can take, including these:


Making changes for the right reasons – While the results of an election may not be a good reason to make changes in your investment portfolio, other factors can certainly lead you to take steps in this direction. For one thing, as you get closer to retirement, you may want to shift some – though certainly not all – of your investment dollars from more growth-oriented vehicles to more conservative ones. Conversely, if you decide,

well in advance, that you might want to retire earlier than you originally thought, you may need to invest more aggressively, being aware of the increased risk involved.

- Following a long-term strategy In pretty much all walks of life, there are no shortcuts to success – and the same is true with investing. You need to follow a long-term strategy based on your goals, risk tolerance and time horizon, and you need the patience and perseverance to keep investing in all markets – up, down and sideways.
- Avoiding mistakes Many people think of an investment mistake as failing to "get in on the ground floor" of some company that ultimately grew to huge proportions. But it's pretty hard to become an early investor in companies like these, many of which start out as privately held businesses without any stockholders. Furthermore, companies with shorter track records can be much more unpredictable investments. However, you do want to avoid some real mistakes, such as chasing "hot" stocks. By the time you hear about them, they may already be cooling off, and they might not even be appropriate for your needs. Another mistake: failing to diversify your portfolio. If you only own one type of asset, such as growth stocks, you could take a big hit during a market downturn. Spreading your dollars over a wide range of investments can help lower your risk exposure. (However, diversification by itself can't guarantee a profit or protect against all losses.)

After Election Day, regardless of the outcome, you can help keep your portfolio on track by not playing politics with it.
