Third Molars (Wisdom Teeth)

- Wisdom teeth are the most common teeth to be impacted (unable to come into mouth).
- Impacted wisdom teeth can sometimes damage or block neighboring teeth if left in place.
- Wisdom teeth can also be hard to clean, which often can lead to infections, dental decay and sometimes cyst formation.
- Usually it's ideal to have your wisdom teeth removed during the teenage years.
- Wisdom teeth are commonly removed by an Oral and Facial Surgeon under IV sedation or general anesthesia in an office setting. Most people return to school or work after 2 to 3 days.

DAVIE COUNTY GOES BACK TO SCHOOL





















School may have been out for the summer, but that doesn't mean that learning in Davie County ended. More than 180 rising kindergarteners through 5th graders attended summer programs funded by a \$122,000 grant from the Mebane Foundation.

"Students missed months of face-to-face instruction this spring due to coronavirus restrictions and are heading into an uncertain school year this fall," said Larry Colbourne, president of the Foundation. "It was important to the Foundation to support enrichment opportunities to help reduce learning loss. Normally those funds supplement state funding for Davie's summer Read to Achieve Camp; but since the Department of Instruction canceled that requirement for this summer, the money was available to fund other programs."

Jennifer Lynde, DCS chief academic officer, appreciated the Foundation's flexibility. "We are in very difficult times that require us to adapt and make decisions, unlike any in the past. The support of the Mebane Foundation allows us to make decisions better aligned with the needs of children and not strictly funding."

Davie County Schools (DCS) reallocated the funds towards five-week summer enrichment camps for rising 1st through 5th graders at Cooleemee and Cornatzer, since they were the sites of the summer feeding program and kinder camps for rising kindergarteners at all six elementary schools.

Colbourne put her in touch with **Imprints Cares** in Winston-Salem, which offers kindergarten readiness programs for children ages birth to five and expanded learning programs, including summer enrichment day camps, for elementary school students. Since Imprints Cares already had a

curriculum in place for its summer camps in Forsyth County as well as social distancing and cleaning protocols developed through offering crisis childcare, he thought they would be the perfect partner to operate an enrichment camp in Davie County.

DCS and Imprints Cares had only three weeks to prepare. DCS contacted the students and Imprints Cares provided all logistics including hiring, curriculum, before and after camp care, and day-to-day management.

Half of the day was devoted to academics — math, writing, reading, and phonics using Heggerty, a phonemic-awareness program that aligns with the science of reading. The other half focused on STEAM-based enrichment activities incorporating math, science, reasoning, and logic.

Additionally, campers enjoyed three onsite field trips: Birds of Prey from **Allison Outdoor Wilderness Center**, a robotics camp by **Bricked** where students assembled and maneuvered Lego-based remote-controlled cars, and an **outdoor fun day** complete with a drenching courtesy of the Cooleemee and Cornatzer fire departments.

"We wanted there to be social-emotional interaction, academics, and just some good old-fashioned summer camp fun," Shannon Heck, Imprint Cares director development and marketing explained.

Crystal Phillips, a 1st/2nd grade teacher's assistant at Pinebrook Elementary, taught the math component at Cornatzer. She considered the camp to be extremely valuable for the students who participated. "We all know that children tend to backslide in the summer months from one grade to the next. I feel these kids, and most of the others at home, have more so this year than prior summers because of the last quarter being taught remotely."

The kinder camps had a different set of goals — teaching rising kindergarteners how to social distance, wash their




hands, treat others the way they would want to be treated, and most importantly become comfortable with the school setting.

"The purpose of kinder camp is to get the children acclimated to school," says kindergarten teacher **Julie Holt**, who led camp at Pinebrook Elementary. "They get the chance to learn to get along and to socialize which benefits them a lot. They also learn how to get around the school so that they aren't scared. We talk a lot about what the first day will be like so that they will be more comfortable with it. If they are more comfortable with it, their parents are going to be more comfortable with it."

"Although I do at least one academic activity each day, I focus more on getting them socially ready to enter the kindergarten world. If you can get them socially and behaviorally ready, the academic piece will come."

Holt told the students that each of them was special and unique and had their own name which was made up of letters. Pointing to a whiteboard bearing each name, she helped them count the letters, then they traced their names on paper using bingo daubers.

"Kinder camp gives us the opportunity to bond with our students and to instill in them the love of learning and a love for school. I think it is a fabulous thing that we can offer this camp and we appreciate it," she told Colbourne with a smile.





In my 3-1/2 years here, I have witnessed many positive things. Most recently, I was able to see the community come together to respond to COVID-19 and citizens impacted by it. Life has changed for all of us since March 2020. Businesses, families, and individuals will all remember the impact for years to come. - The Inspections team has rolled out an online permitting system to better service citizens.

- The Board of Elections has had a busy year preparing for the **upcoming election** by testing and adding new voting equipment to replace old machines.
- Emergency Services received the American Heart
 Association's Mission Lifeline Award Gold Plus
 recognition for outstanding cardiac care for the 6th
 straight year in a row. In addition, we began providing
 convalescent care service for non-emergency
 transportation for citizens in need of this service.
- Our Public Library is working on updating its strategic plan, and is looking forward to an expansion/renovation for a Youth Services area later this year.
- The Public Utilities team will complete the Northeast
 Davie Sewer Project. The county and Town of Mocksville
 are also partnering together on a Joint Utility Study that
 will yield needed upgrades to service the remainder of the
 county. Together, because of good foresight, these two
 projects will meet the water and sewer demands of the
 county for 80 plus years.
- Our Recreation and Parks team worked hard to get us to the grand opening of the new Davie County Community Park.

I want to thank all of the Davie County Government staff for the difference they make in the lives of this community. You may or may not see the results of their work directly, but they are there when you need them. They are unsung heroes. Sometimes the small things help brighten up one's day — a smile or kind word or an intentional generous action. Never underestimate the power of a simple "thank you" to those who serve daily.







Steps for Learning Success

Navigating this school year - whether you're homeschooling, participating in the Davie County Schools Virtual Academy, or in the hybrid in-person/online Plan B - will be challenging for both parents and students. There are sure to be issues with technology and time management, but by following a few simple tips you can minimize frustrations and improve your child's opportunities for success.

- Create a dedicated at-home workspace. Some families are going all out on their virtual learning space, with color coordinated accessories and motivational posters. Whatever your home learning space looks like, make sure it is an area free from distractions (like the television or video games), comfortable, clear of clutter, and equipped with all the tools your child will need for the day. This includes fully charged devices, textbooks, calculators, notes and notebooks, and pencils and pens (yes, they still use those!).
- 2. **Establish the ground rules.** Virtual learning may be synchronous (real time teaching, like Zoom or Google Meet) or asynchronous (recorded lessons). Either way, students need a schedule and clear expectations. This

is especially important if parents are working and students are getting help from neighborhood groups, outside learning facilitators, or are working on their own. Virtual learning takes discipline and motivation. By setting clear expectations and regularly checking in with your child, you can help them stay on track.

- Take regular breaks. Sitting at a computer working for hours on end isn't healthy for your body or your mind. Taking frequent, planned breaks for snacks, physical activity, and mental breaks are good for everyone.
- 4. **Reach out.** Teachers, administrators, and other families are there to help you and your child succeed. It is in everyone's best interest that they do!
- 5. **Stay positive.** This may be the most difficult thing for all of us. Our children are looking for us to set the example. If we normalize mask wearing, it's not such a big deal. If we are patient with technology, they will be, too. If we use the long car rider line to talk to our children, we're making a connection instead of complaining about it taking too long.
- 6. **Show grace.** Teachers and administrators aren't perfect, and they're going to make mistakes. They're going to do things that you don't agree with, or not respond fast enough, or forget to email you back. Remember that many of them are trying to navigate virtual learning with their own children, as well. Your children aren't perfect, either. There will be days when they won't come out from under their desks or fuss and fight because they are just OVER IT. Lastly, give yourself some grace. Those cute color-coded folders may be in the trash by Halloween, and that's okay. We're all doing the best we can, and right now that's








Built on 45 acres with a broad coalition of support — including the Town of Mocksville, Davie County, local businesses, county citizens, and the state — the Davie Campus of DCCC opened in 1994 with a mission to provide convenient, career-focused education.

By its 10th anniversary, the Davie Campus featured three buildings and an emergency services training facility. In 2008, the Davie Education Center opened in Bermuda Run. A major expansion project in early 2009 added 8,500 square feet of new space. The first floor of the Community Building was renovated to house a modern library. Another major renovation of the Gantt Building was completed in Fall 2012 to house the **Davie County Early College High School**. And through a partnership with **Wake Forest Baptist Health** and **Davie County**, DCCC for several years used the former Davie County Hospital for new programs in the health sciences. Such partnerships with health care providers across DCCC's service area allow the College to continue to expand how it prepares health care workers for a rapidly-changing landscape.

As Davie Medical Center and Wake Forest Baptist Health as a whole have increased the number of surgeries, procedures and outpatient clinic visits across the entire health system, patients and families have likely noticed some changes designed to help maintain a safe environment for all.

"When the protocol was to shelter in place, that kept our volumes low at Davie Medical Center. This gave staff the extra time needed to prepare and get measures in place to make sure staff and patients are safe and COVID-Protected," said Matt Cline, M.D., Chief Medical Officer at Davie Medical Center.

In-person visits have resumed, but telephone, virtual and e-visits are still offered.

"Virtual visits may remain the best option for some, but we know there are health conditions that need to be addressed and treated in person. A lot of our patients have been waiting on surgeries that increase their quality of life like joint replacement surgery. COVID-19 has changed the way we operate but we hope the community can appreciate all that we have done to make to make sure they are protected," Cline said.

"COVID-19 has made a lot of people across the country scared to come to hospitals. Here at Davie Medical Center, we saw a dramatic drop in the amount of people we were treating in the Emergency Department and that was concerning to us because we know there are people out there having heart attacks, strokes and other issues that need emergent attention. We've gradually started seeing more people come in but unfortunately, many are coming in later than they should have. We know in those situations, the earlier we can treat a patient, the better."

"We want to urge those in our community to not delay receiving the care that they need and to have the peace

of mind that Davie Medical Center is doing everything we can to keep patients and staff safe."

Some of the changes that have been made include:

- Practicing social distancing in all of our clinic locations
- Minimizing wait times in common areas, like waiting rooms
- Asking our patients to join all providers and clinic staff in wearing masks
- · Limiting visitors, with few exceptions
- Cleaning our facilities with strict sanitation protocols
- Conducting screenings for COVID-19 symptoms upon arrival
- Offering expanded access to virtual visits via video or telephone
- Staffing Respiratory Assessment Clinics for patients with COVID-19 or flu-like symptoms

"Beyond these measures, we are really trying to go the extra mile for our patients during this stressful time," Cline said. "We have negative pressure rooms that help circulate air out of the department and away from staff and patients. These special rooms have multiple sections so a provider can go in the first room and close the door before entering the main room with the patient. Within these rooms, we have also added UV lights that can help kill airborne viruses. We're also promoting good hand hygiene for patients and staff to prevent the transmission of COVID-19 and other illnesses."

"Davie Medical Center staff is doing all we can to keep those who visit our hospital and those in the community safe and COVID-Protected."
