Tips for Grilling a Great Steak

- Preheat the grill so the grates are nice and hot before putting the steaks on.
- Once you've placed the steak on the grates, try to move it as little as possible.
- Only flip your steak once to keep it from sticking to the grates and to cook it evenly on both sides.
- ☐ Don't cut into your steak to check for readiness! This will let the juices run out and dry out your steak. Use a thermometer or the hand test.
- Once cooked, allow steak to rest for at least five minutes before cutting into it to preserve the juices and keep it from drying out.

Nothing says summer like a great meal cooked on the grill! Whether you're grilling a nice steak, juicy piece of chicken or charring some garden vegetables — these tips and recipes are sure to put the YUM in your summer meal.

Tips for Grilling Great Chicken

- ☐ Set your grill at medium heat and allow it to preheat before adding the chicken.
- ☐ To keep the chicken from sticking, brush a bit of oil on the grill.
- ☐ Cook for about 5 6 minutes per side, depending on the thickness of the chicken breast.
- ☐ The chicken needs to reach 165 degrees to ensure that it is completely cooked through.

Steak Marinade (courtesy of allrecipes.com)

1/3 cup soy sauce

½ cup olive oil

1/3 cup fresh lemon juice

1/4 cup Worcestershire sauce

1½ Tbs garlic powder

3 Tbs dried basil

1 ½ Tbs dried parsley flakes

1 tsp ground white pepper

1/4 tsp hot pepper sauce (optional)

1 tsp dried minced garlic (optional)

Step 1: Place the soy sauce, olive oil, lemon juice, Worcestershire sauce, garlic powder, basil, parsley, and pepper in a blender. Add hot pepper sauce and garlic, if desired. Blend on high speed for 30 seconds until thoroughly mixed.

Step 2: Pour marinade over desired type of meat. Cover, and refrigerate for up to 8 hours. Cook meat as desired.

Chicken Marinade (courtesy of modernhoney.com)

1/3 - 1/2 cup extra virgin olive oil depending on preference

3 Tbs fresh lemon juice

3 Tbs soy sauce

2 Tbs balsamic vinegar

1/4 cup brown sugar

1 Tbs Worcestershire sauce

3 garlic cloves minced or 1/2 tsp garlic powder

1-1/2 tsp salt

1tsp pepper

In a bowl, stir together oil, lemon juice, soy sauce, balsamic vinegar, brown sugar, Worcestershire sauce, garlic, salt, and pepper.

Pierce chicken breasts with a fork all over. Place in a large Ziploc bag. Pour marinade over chicken.

Let marinate for at least 30 minutes. 4 - 5 hours is ideal.

Preheat grill to medium heat. Brush grill with oil to prevent sticking.

Place chicken on the grill. Cook for approximately 5 - 6 minutes per side, depending on the thickness of chicken. The internal temperature of the chicken should reach 165 degrees.

Remove chicken from grill and let rest for 5 minutes.

Amazing Grilled Veggies

Don't worry about fussing with a grilling basket or skewer–keep it simple and grill your veggies directly on the grill. Be sure to cut the veggies in large chunks and lightly coat with olive oil to prevent them from sticking. Most vegetables are ready after 2-4 minutes of grilling and if you plan to marinate, do that after grilling — cooked veggies absorb flavor best!

To help get you started, here are some suggestions that grill especially well:

- · zucchini/squash
- asparagus
- eggplant

- mushrooms
- bell peppers
- red onion





This is my family's story about our decision to become a foster family.

Several of my childhood friends were adopted and I always had it in my heart that it was something I wanted to do. I didn't know when or how, but I felt like someday it might be my reality.

My husband, on the other hand, was not initially on board. His youngest sibling was adopted internationally and the journey has been difficult.

How were we to reconcile this? We both prayed for clarity and necessary heart change and so many more things. In late 2017 we started exploring options. At the time, our sons were ages five and two and our hearts felt ready for another child. I had been talking to friends who had adopted and started making phone calls to adoption agencies.

Here's the thing. NO ONE needed families. Even our local Family Services office had a two year wait list for infant adoption. One day I muttered, "Do you think God wants us to foster?" Fostering was so hard. All of the stories seemed horrendous. I was not sure how we could ever raise children for an extended period of time and then they leave our family. But, faith gave us fortitude.

After prayer and research, we decided to go with Davie DSS (Department of Social Services), which meant that we were working directly with the county and served as the first line of families consulted for placement.

Our training taught us about childhood trauma with the goal of preparing us for anything. We also had to go through extensive background checks, references, finger printing, fire inspections, home studies and more. Finally, on December 19, 2018 we became licensed foster parents. I was so excited. So terrified. So many things.

As the process started, we also had questions about the impact on our family. What if this is too hard on our

marriage? On our kids? On our time? What if the children hate

being with our family? What ages work best for our family? How will we decide if a placement is right?

Soon after becoming licensed, I received a message about placement being needed for a toddler and infant. At this point, there was very little information on the children. I had a lump in my throat. My husband and I prayed. We both cried. We prayed more. We knew. It was a clear "yes" from God.

The entire drive to get the children, I sang my favorite worship songs to keep me calm as I thought: What would I say to them? What did they look like? How would they respond to me?

I pulled into the parking lot and waited for the DSS van to arrive with nervous anticipation. As the social worker opened the van door and started sharing information, an adorable little boy and precious baby peered out at me. The boy told me about his favorite dinosaurs. His smile was contagious. I loved them instantly.

At home, I took a deep breath of hope as I prepared to introduce these children to their temporary family. There were instant smiles. Fast camaraderie. That night my husband and I stared at one another. It was real! There were four children asleep in our home.

The next morning, I quickly let several colleagues, close friends, family members and prayer warriors know that we had welcomed two children into our home. You know the saying, "God doesn't call the equipped, he equips the called"? Within minutes a meal schedule had been created and there were baby supplies on our porch. Every single thing we needed God provided with little to no effort on our part. We were able to focus on the big rocks — share love, be consistent, keep moving forward.

blueberry dressing

To make blueberry dressing: In blender, process blueberries, balsamic vinegar, honey, lemon juice, olive oil and salt and pepper, to taste, until smooth. Set aside.

To prepare salad: Cut apples into 1/4-inch thick slices. Using 1-1/2-inch diameter star-shaped cutter, cut apple slices into stars.

Place lettuce mix in large bowl; add apples, strawberries and blueberries. Sprinkle with pecans. Before serving, drizzle each salad with blueberry dressing.

3 ripe avocados, halved and pitted 1/2 cup finely chopped Vidalia onion 1/2 cup snipped fresh cilantro 1 lime, juice only bottled hot pepper sauce, to taste 1 Granny Smith apple, peeled, cored and finely chopped kosher salt, to taste

In bowl, use fork to mash avocados, onion, cilantro, lime juice and hot pepper sauce to desired consistency. Stir in apple and season with salt, to taste.

1 cup raspberries, divided

3 tablespoons honey

In blender, blend watermelon, 1/2 cup blueberries, 1/2 cup raspberries and honey until smooth. Press through fine mesh strainer to remove pulp and seeds.

Fill ice pop molds 3/4 full with liquid. Add remaining whole blueberries and raspberries to molds. Insert sticks and freeze at least 4 hours, or until completely frozen.


